DURING THE PERIOD THE CHARITY SECURED DONATIONS OF £48,294 FOR THE VARIOUS PROJECTS AND EXPENDED £43,039 OF WHICH GRANTS FOR PROJECTS TOTALLED £42,859. THIS GENERATED A SURPLUS FOR THE PERIOD OF £5,255 WHICH THE TRUSTEES INTEND TO USE FOR FUTURE CHARITABLE EXPENDITURE. THE TOTAL FUNDS HELD AT THE END OF THE PERIOD WERE £12,171. THE TRUSTEES HAVE A POLICY NOT TO HOLD RESERVES FOR OPERATIONAL COSTS BUT ANY FUNDS HELD WILL BE USED FOR FUTURE CHARITABLE PROJECTS AND ADMINISTRATION COSTS.
