Brief statement of the charity's policy on reserves

DURING THE PERIOD THE CHARITY SECURED DONATIONS OF £16,249 FOR THE VARIOUS PROJECTS AND EXPENDED £18,972 OF WHICH GRANTS FOR PROJECTS TOTALLED £17,292. THIS GENERATED A DEFICIT FOR THE PERIOD OF £2,723 WHICH WAS COVERED BY GENERAL FUNDS BROUGHT FORWARD. THE TOTAL REMAINING FUNDS HELD AT THE END OF THE PERIOD WERE £9,448. THE TRUSTEES HAVE A POLICY NOT TO HOLD RESERVES FOR OPERATIONAL COSTS BUT ANY FUNDS HELD WILL BE USED FOR FUTURE CHARITABLE PROJECTS AND ADMINISTRATION COSTS.
