FOR THE PERIOD ENDED 31 DECEMBER 2024

The trustees submit their report and financial statement for The Redeemed Christian Church of God - House of Mercy High Wycombe (The Charity) for the period ended 31 December 2024. The trustees confirm that the trustees' report and financial statements comply with current statutory requirements and the provisions of the regulators.

STRUCTURE, GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT

The Redeemed Christian Church of God - House of Mercy High Wycombe is a church plant of The Redeemed Christian Church of God House of Mercy Aylesbury. It was registered as a charity in England and Wales with a trust deed dated 1 January 2016. It was registered with Charity Number 1183158. The trustees, which consist of three members, manage the activities of the charity. The parish pastor oversees the church.

POLICIES ADOPTED FOR THE INDUCTION AND TRAINING OF NEW TRUSTEES

The induction process for a newly appointed trustee consists of an initial meeting with the chair and other members of the board, followed by short meetings with the parish pastor on the powers and responsibilities of the trustees.

ORGANISATIONAL STRUCTURE AND DECISION MAKING

The trustees meet regularly to manage the affairs of the organisation while the parish pastor oversees the spiritual activities of the church.

RELATED PARTY TRANSACTION

RCCG - House of Mercy High Wycombe is a parish of The Redeemed Christian Church of God with parishes all over the world. The parish's relationship with other parishes is governed by an Agreement Common purposes' through RCCG House of Mercy Aylesbury.

RISK MANAGEMENT

The trustees have assessed the major risks to which the charity is exposed, in particular those related to operations and finances of the charity, and are satisfied that systems are in place to mitigate our exposures to major risks.

OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

The principal object is the advancement of Christian faith in accordance with the statement of beliefs of The Redeemed Christian Church of God, and the relief of poverty. To achieve its objectives, the church adopted the following strategies:

Running Sunday worship services, prayer meetings and midweek bible study, and
Supporting other charities and Christian events,

PUBLIC BENEFITS

The Church's Sunday and mid-week services are open to the general public to build on their Christian faith. Apart from its Church activities, the charity was involved in the following public benefit efforts:

- Contributing to food banks for the less privileged in our community and giving out food items in the local market monthly.
- Holding outreaches in areas of interest to our community. In the year we shared the joy of and with our community by organising a Carol service, we also celebrated the Mothers' day in our community. We gave gifts, provide support and share the message of goodwill from the gospel in the community.
- During the pandemic, the church supported members of community who are in need through the Love Your Neighbour project.

Our efforts are geared towards supporting the programmes of our local community, promoting cohesion in our community, and impacting the lives of the young people and the elderly.

GRANT MAKING POLICY

The church supports visiting ministers of the gospel both within and outside the United Kingdom. Support is also given to RCCG Central Office, World Evangelism Mission, and other RCCG events. The Church supports other charities and missionary that shares its objects in the advancement of Christian faith and relief of poverty. The church gives occasional welfare grants to members of the community who are in need.

VOLUNTEERS

The church is grateful for the unstinting efforts of its volunteers who are involved in providing services for the charity. It is estimated that over 1000 hours was provided by volunteers during the year. If this is conservatively valued at £7.50 per hour, the volunteers effort will amount to over £7,500.

REVIEW OF ACTIVITIES

The church continues to enjoy tremendous growth in its physical and spiritual life during the year, and in advancement of Christian faith in accordance with the doctrines set out in its statement of faith contained in our governing document.

RESERVES POLICY

The trustee's policy is to have unrestricted and uncommitted funds (free reserves) to cover 3 to 6 months of resources expended. They feel that this would enable the current activities to continue if there is any significant drop in funding. It would obviously be necessary to consider how the funding would be replaced or activities changed.

The trustees are responsible for preparing the annual report and financial statements in accordance with applicable laws and regulations.

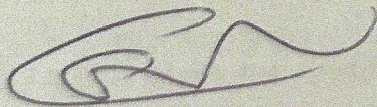

- Prepare the financial statements on a going concern basis unless it is inappropriate to presume that the company will continue in operation.

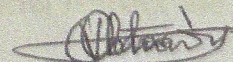

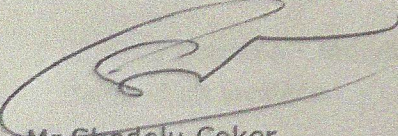

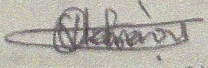

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

(1.1) Basis of preparation of financial statements

The financial statements have been prepared with Statement of Recommended Practice (SORP), "Accounting and Reporting by Charities published in March 2005 and applicable accounting standards.

(1.2) Incoming resources

All incoming resources are included in the statement of financial activities when the charity is legally entitled to the income and the amount can be reasonably quantified with reasonable accuracy.

(1.3) Resources expended

All expenditures are accounted for on an accrual basis. Management and governance costs are cost incurred in connection with administration and compliance with statutory requirement
