Activities

Between January and March 2025, The Time to Shine Project funded and delivered a singing initiative at Maya's Community Support Centre which supports disadvantaged residents in the Herne Bay area.

In the spring and summer, the project facilitator led a choir at the Third Age Project, a Camden-based non-profit organisation focused on reducing loneliness among older adults.

Both programs were made possible by the Lottery Fund grant which was received in 2024.

Finance

Total income for the period was £797, comprising £276 in donations and £521 from fundraising.

Expenditure totalled £4,127, with principal costs allocated to the community support hub (£1,208) and the Third Age Project Choir (£2,264).

Trustees

Jacqueline Tolhurst joined as Trustee in December 2024, followed by Angela Wragg in January 2025. Michael Grant, Helen Hordle, Wendy Heeley, and Rebecca Johnson stepped down during the year.

Activities

During spring 2024 we funded and ran a 10 week Singing for Mental Wellbeing project at a mental health hub in Whitstable. This was very well received by the participants, many of whom reported improvements in their mental wellbeing and confidence. The project featured on the BBC One Show programme and ended with a performance for friends and family.

We successfully applied for a grant of £11,100 from the Lottery fund. The grant is to be used for similar projects that meet our charitable aims over the next two years. The first project is planned to start in January 2025 at a Community Support Centre in Herne Bay.

Finance

During the period, the Charity received income of £11,511. The sources of income were donations (£196), fundraising (£215), the Lottery Fund grant (£11,100).

Expenditure was £3,212, of which the main items were the mental health wellbeing project (£2,198) and website and publicity (£536).

Trustees

Michael Grant and Ashleigh Devlin were appointed as Trustees in July 2024.

Activities

We continued to provide choirs for NHS staff throughout the year. Discussions took place with a number of organisations with the expectation of commencing a new project in early 2024.

The Charity's newly revamped website was launched with the aim of publicising past work and inviting new projects.

A fundraising concert in December 2022 raised £1,460.

Finance

During the period, the Charity received income of £11,740. The sources of income were donations (£296), fundraising (£1,310 net), and provision of the NHS choir (£9,075).

Expenditure was £10,042, of which the main items were the NHS Choir (£7,587) and development of the website (£1,250).

Trustees

Activities

Having operated on an online basis during the height of the Covid pandemic, the NHS choirs resumed full activities during the year. However, activities with more vulnerable groups have been slower to restart. The charity is actively researching vulnerable groups to work with and has identified additional project facilitators who will increase the capacity of the charity in developing future projects. We have also developed a new website which is due to be launched in Spring 2023.

A fundraising choir concert In July 2022 raised £2,210, and the charity's founder raised over £1,000 with a sponsored run.

Finance

During the period, the Charity received income of £12,543. The sources of income were donations (£311), fundraising (£3,067 net), and provision of the NHS choir (£8,134).

Expenditure was £9,343, of which the main item was the NHS Choir (£7,214).

Trustees

Rebecca Johnson, Sarah Purchase, Martin Newlan, Helen Hordle, and Wendy Heeley were appointed as trustees in March 2022 and Hannah Patel in May 2022.

Activities

Due to the ongoing Covid-19 pandemic, normal activities were again significantly curtailed.

The NHS choirs ran on a virtual basis on Zoom for the whole of the year. In addition to the online choir sessions, Michael Grant and the choirs produced two videos for Kent Community NHS Foundation Trust. The first was to celebrate LGBTQ+ month in February 2021, and the second to mark and recognise bereavement and illnesses that had affected staff during the pandemic. This video was also shown publicly at the Trust's annual members' meeting.

Finance

During the period, the Charity received income of £10,674. The sources of income were donations (£294) and provision of the NHS choir (£10,380).

Expenditure was £8,281, of which the main item was the NHS Choir (£8,090).

Trustees

Carol Sanigar stood down as a trustee at the end of her term.
