The Stuart and Cherrilyn Keogh Foundation Trustees Annual Report 31.3.25

As reported previously, draft agreements were sent to Newquay Town Council who forwarded to their solicitors. By 31st March 2024 no agreement had been reached.

During May 2024 the trustees had several meetings with their solicitors trying to progress matters. In June 2024 a meeting was held between two trustees and Newquay Town Council to discuss the sticking points, and it was considered this was a successful meeting. It was hoped agreement would be completed by September. However, by the end of July still no word had been received from the council's solicitors.

Unfortunately, the situation dragged on until mid-November 2024 when the CEO of Newquay Town Council sent an email to say there was one small amendment to be made which was minor. A month later the Trusts solicitors were sent a new draft with extensive amendments, some concerning items that had already been agreed!

Two trustees had a further meeting with the Trusts solicitors on 18th December 2024, and the solicitors responded to the Councils solicitors on 19th December 2024. Another 3 months were lost because of staff holidays and sickness (we were advised) at Newquay Town Council. On hearing nothing from the Council or its solicitors the Trustees wrote on 22nd January to the CEO of the Council expressing disappointment at the slow progress, although the trustees were assured that the project was receiving constant and due attention. Sadly however, there was no evidence of such and at 31st March 2025 the legal agreements needed were still outstanding.

Although the Trustees had high hopes that this project would be finalised by the Spring of 2025, our hopes were dashed by the slowness of Newquay Town Council and its solicitors.

Postscript

The Deed of Gift was signed later in 2025 and it is now hoped that building the base for the Surf Statue will start in late January 2026, with the statue being erected in Spring 2026.



At the beginning of April 2023 the production of the support structure was under way as was the casting of the surfer figure and the wave feature. However, the surfboard produced by the artist was not suitable and a local Newquay surfboard designer produced a computer model of a board that would take the support structure of the surfer figure. This was then produced by a local surfboard manufacturer and shipped to the foundry at the end of May 2023.

During July the name of the surf statue was trademarked as *Surfer of the South*. At the beginning of August, the support structure was transported to the foundry and the surfer figure and surfboard were nearly complete.

In mid-August 2023, several trustees visited the foundry and were really pleased with the work thus far. Sadly, a short time following the visit, Stuart Keogh became very poorly and had to be admitted to hospital and at the beginning of September he sadly passed away. In September another trustee visit to the foundry was made to discuss patination of the figure and the surfboard. By mid-November everything was complete and the support structure for the surf figure on the surfboard and the wave structure were transported to Newquay where they were put into storage.

During the year 3D models were made of the statue; one approximately 12 inches high and another 6 inches high. The smaller model was given to Blue Hills Tin who were asked to produce a replica in Cornish tin. It is hoped that in the future these models can be used as prizes for a Newquay Surf Contest.

In July /August 2023 the Deed of Gift drawn up by the Foundations solicitors was given to the Town Council for approval, who sent it on to their solicitors. By year end this agreement had still not been agreed. This meant the opportunity to have the statue in place for the 2024 summer season was lost.

In early 2024 a website for the Foundation was set up. When the statue is in situ there will be an information plaque with a QR code that will take the public to the web site with a full story of the history of surfing in Newquay and the UK, created by surf historian Roger Mansfield."



The results of the further survey and consultation conducted by Newquay Town Council early in 2022 concluded that the Killacourt site in Newquay would be the most appropriate location for the surf statue. This is the site that the Foundation has been proposing since 2019.

At the full Council meeting in September 2022, the Council agreed to accept the statue and have it placed on the Killacourt site. However, the Foundation was tasked with obtaining planning permission to do so.

The initial planning application was submitted in October 2022. This was rejected by the planning committee which asked for various reports including CGI photo images of the statue in situ taken from various points around the Killacourt site. This was resubmitted to the planning committee in January 2023 following which full planning permission was granted by Cornwall Council in February 2023.

Meanwhile a foundry was selected and deposit paid in September 2022 to commence production of the statue. The figure of the surfer was moulded and cast in December 2022 and the other components were, at the year end, in production. In March, the Trustees engaged a fabricating company to construct the stainless steel support structure for the statue, which was also in production at the year end. Likewise, the Trustees are consulting with builders to obtain quotes for the construction of the statue base.

The Trustees have been in contact with Buckingham Palace through the High Sheriff of Cornwall to ask if Prince William would be able to unveil the statue in his capacity as the Duke of Cornwall. The Palace have asked for progress reports and a specific date which the Trustees are currently unable to provide.

Early in the year, it became apparent that negotiations with Newquay Town Council for the gift of the Surf Statue were making little progress.

A local supportive Councillor suggested that the Trustees should try and gain public support as the Council would find it difficult to ignore such support. As a result, various companies were engaged to provide communication and media support, as well as to commission a survey and petition. A Facebook page was set up as part of the communication strategy and a short video was posted to this page to help publicise Newquay's surfing heritage.

There was overwhelming support for the surf statue arising from the survey, and the results were presented to the Town Council for consideration.

The Council however decided they wished to conduct another survey of their own. A working party was established to find a suitable site, even though a previous working party had not been able to recommend an alternative to that proposed by the Trustees. As at 31st March 2022 the results were still awaited.



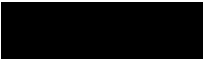
