A derelict Fishermen's Rest (small chapel) has been restored and put back to its original use, one of community focus. This year we plan to install some catering equipment to be able to serve coffee and refreshments as well as redecorate. Youth and families of the fishing community have congregated and met in the building. Seniors, retired folk and even persons with dementia have found inspiration and respite in the project.</p>

All the funds held currently are unrestricted. The charity is currently working with a fundraiser to seek funding that would enable us to expand activities as well as employing someone in the role of Operations manager to oversee these activities. As these activities grow, there will be a need for the charity to review its policy on holding reserves. However, with the continuation of the pandemic, all activities have been cut back and COVID guidance respected. We hope this will change shortly.
