We have been heavily involved in supporting and taking part in Amyloidosis surveys organised by the Pharma companies and hospitals.</p> <p>In February we started a series of joint projects with the National Amyloidosis Centre in London and Pharma company to make awareness of the importance of early diagnoses of the disease. We have started the Afro-Caribbean Community outreach and disease awareness campaign.</p>

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
