

Chair of Trustees annual report for the year April 2023 to 2024

Date 5th April 2024

It was unfortunately not possible to recommence the charity's activities during the year. At an online meeting of the trustees on 3rd June, 2023 it was agreed that it was not currently practical to undertake new projects during 2023 and early 2024.

However, at an online meeting of the trustees on 18th March, 2024 it was provisionally agreed that, as a prelude to further activity over the coming year and beyond, we would aim to actively support two projects outlined to us by the artistic director of our initiating 2017 project, Voices Beyond Divisions , Asha Parkinson involving possible collaboration with other charitable and educational organisations. The first is an international project with young people in several countries including current conflict zones focusing on the theme of water, its importance and meaning. The second involves projected workshops led by Arab refugee musicians living in London with young people in Oxford and elsewhere. We have requested further details of these projects for our June trustees meeting.



Chair of Trustees annual report for the year April 2020 to 2021

Date 5th April 2021

At an online meeting of trustees on Monday, 1st June, 2020 it was agreed to continue the suspension of the charity's activities and planning during the Covid crisis. It was agreed that, because of uncertainties as to when it would be possible to mount projects involving in-person group projects, we could not make formal plans to do so, nor should we fundraise until we could be confident that projects could go ahead. Trustees remained in touch informally and monitored the situation, meeting formally again on March, 21st 2021 and agreeing to continue the suspension until government guidelines indicated that gatherings could happen safely.

Trustees also took a decision to extend the board of trustees, inviting new trustees to reflect greater diversity. Because of the abnormal situation and the suspension of activities, existing trustees agreed to continue in their current roles. New trustees will be invited during the coming year and we are reviewing possibilities meanwhile.

Once again It is hoped that we will be able to regain momentum when the current pandemic has ended and face-to-face activities can be resumed.
