On 23/04/2024, 144 dual galvanized desks, 11 hexagonal desks and 62 Kindergarten chairs were donated to Kogri Primary School in Jirapa, Upper West Region of Ghana, as part of the SIT A CHILD Project in Rural Ghana.

On 26/04/2024, 40 dual galvanized desks were donated to Asuom Islamic Primary School in Asuom, Eastern Region of Ghana, as part of the SIT A CHILD Project in Rural Ghana.

On 18/11/2024, 50 dual galvanized desks, 15 hexagonal desks and 90 Kindergarten chairs were donated to AME Zion elementary School in Tamale, Northern Region of Ghana, as part of the SIT A CHILD Project in Rural Ghana.

On 19/11/2024, 64 dual galvanized desks were donated to Busa M/A Primary School in Wa, Upper East Region of Ghana, as part of the SIT A CHILD Project in Rural Ghana.

This contribution provided a conducive environment for the children in that under privilege community to study thereby giving them a chance of a brighter education and a brighter future.
