Following the release of the first instalment of funding to the partner charity, the Treasurer conducted a follow-up visit to the charity's premises to review the implementation of the agreed activities. During this visit, the Treasurer examined the charity's financial records and supporting documentation to verify that the funds had been utilised strictly in accordance with the agreed funding plan and designated purposes.

The review included checks of the relevant accounts, expenditure records, and supporting evidence relating to the funded activities. These checks provided assurance that the monies had been applied appropriately and in line with the objectives agreed between both organisations.

Having completed this review and being fully satisfied with the transparency of the records and the proper use of the funds, the Board confirmed its intention to proceed with the release of further funding in accordance with the partnership agreement. We will continue to maintain regular engagement with the partner charity, including ongoing monitoring and evaluation, to ensure accountability, proper stewardship of funds, and continued alignment with our charitable objectives.

After a thorough due diligence process, we successfully identified an established charity whose work is in direct accordance with our charitable aims.

The Treasurer and General Secretary held several meetings with representatives of the identified charity and carried out multiple site visits to assess their operations, impact, and governance structure. These engagements provided a high level of assurance regarding the alignment of their activities with our mission and the robustness of their internal controls.

After careful consideration and with the full satisfaction of the Board, we formalised a partnership with the charity. As part of our agreed collaboration, we approved the release of the first instalment of funding. This contribution will be directed towards agreed activities that advance our charitable objectives, in accordance with the mutually developed funding plan.
