FOSV have successfully established Sherbucks (a consistent revenue-generating community cafe) and organised major fundraisers like the annual Fireworks Event and a Circus. Funds raised have directly led to tangible improvements, including the refurbishment of library furniture, and the financial support of operating new school minibus. FOSV also consistently runs smaller engagement activities (discos, seasonal fairs) and provides student recognition (Year 6 Leavers Books).</p> <p>The charity's work provides a richer learning environment (improved library), increased opportunities (funding for the minibus expands access to trips/sporting events), and enhanced well-being (community events and transition support via Leavers Books).</p> <p>FOSV acts as a vital agent for community cohesion. Initiatives like Sherbucks and the major public events strengthen local bonds, promote active civic participation, and enhance the overall social environment of the neighbourhood.</p>
