The church has been regularly collecting store cupboard goods which are provide to the local charity 'Hopeworx' in support of their foodbank.

The Youth Group has grown to a regular group of up to 20 teenagers who currently meet on a monthly basis. In spring 2025 the Church has started a weekly bible study group for 7-11 year olds.

The Church has continued to support a small team who provide street evangelism in the local area with the provision of evangelistic materials, practical and prayer support. Many of those who met these evangelists have followed up the meeting with a visit to the church for a service or other meeting.
