Trustees Annual Report Year Ending 30th June 2025

Club is non-profit voluntary Charity Club, Seven Kings Lions Club (CIO) was registered with the Charities Commission number 1185513 on 26th September 2019 and has 3 trustees and 5 volunteers.

Funding is raised through different sources i.e. Just Giving, Go Fund Me, Networking Events, Corporate, Text To Donate etc.

Our main projects delivered:

- This year club had engaged with "Haven House Foundation Ltd", which is a local hospice for young children. They provide specialised care and physical comfort and emotional support to both the child and the parents. Foundation was in need of 6 specialised Mattresses and beddings, club purchased these at cost of £2,590.00 and presented to the foundation.
- Giving Tree initiative grant was received from "Groundwork UK (Tesco plc)" for an amount of £1,500.00. Club would like to thank "Groundwork UK (Tesco plc)" for their continuous support for this initiative.
- Donation was also received from "Lloyds Bank Foundation" for an amount of £2,500.00. Club would like to thank them for their support.
- Donation was also received from "Arnold Clark Automobiles Limited" for an amount of £2,500.00. Club would like to thank them for their support.
- Donation was also received from "Good Hotel" for an amount of £500.00. Club would like to thank them for their support.
- There was also aggregate amount of £2,515.00 that were donated to Lions Club International projects.
- Giving Tree initiative, this year identified disadvantaged school children in the Redbridge Borough to whom club provided gifts that the child chose for and may not otherwise receive. Club distributed approximately 53 Christmas Gift to children at a total cost of £372.77.
- Working with a team in Punjab in India we have teamed up with Adampur Lions Hospital to provide a monthly eye care initiative. Every month 15 very needy people are identified, to whom we provide a free eye test and prescription glasses. The total cost to us per patient is in the region of £5.30. £1539.89 was raised for this initiative in a short space of time and 123 patients were treated at cost of £652.00. The initiative has been expanded to also cater for a local school which served 53 children from very poor backgrounds. The children have had their eye tested and this initiative took it further to also have their dental checked whilst providing a free toothbrush and toothpaste to promote good dental health practice.
- Kiva Funding is our ongoing project, reported as Off-Balance Sheet item. To date the club has provided \$1,416.17 such business enterprise loans that have helped 64 individuals to date. Note 2. This year there were 2 more loans defaulted and to date there are total 3 defaults.
- Club collected over 1000 pair of used and discarded prescription glasses, majority of these glasses were supplied by local branch of "Boots Opticians" as well as independent Opticians. We would like to thank these Opticians for their continued support in this initiative, which were supplied to Lions Club International who would then distribute them internationally to help disadvantage patients improve their vision.

Club is non-profit voluntary Charity Club, Seven Kings Lions Club (CIO) was registered with the Charities Commission number 1185513 on 26th September 2019 and has 3 trustees and 7 volunteers.

Funding is raised through different sources i.e. Just Giving, Go Fund Me, Networking Events etc.

Our main projects delivered:

- This year club had engaged with "Haven House Foundation Ltd", which is a local hospice for young children. They provide specialised care and physical comfort and emotional support to both the child and the parents. Foundation was in need of CADD pump that administers the medication and also for training purpose. Club purchased the pump at the cost £2,750.00 and presented to the foundation.
- A generous Giving Tree initiative grant was received from "Groundwork UK (Tesco plc)" for an amount of £1,000.00. Club would like to thank "Groundwork UK (Tesco plc)" for their continuous support for this initiative.
- A generous donation was also received from "Kshatriya Sevak Mandal U.K" for an amount of £501.00. Club would like to thank them for their support.
- There were also small aggregate amount of £300.00 that were donated to Lions Club International projects.
- Giving Tree initiative, this year identified disadvantaged school children in the Redbridge Borough to whom club provided gifts that the child chose for and may not otherwise receive. Club distributed approximately 106 Christmas Gift to children at a total cost of £1,001.52.
- Food project, £599.99 worth of food supplies were donated to a local Gurudwara who had prepared meals and distributed to the needy and homeless in the community.
- Kiva Funding is our ongoing project, and they were not included in previous year's reports. This year we have included as **Off Balance Sheet item**. These figures are reported in US dollars, where the club provides business enterprise loans and personal support to individuals on a global basis as an interest free revolving loan allowing them to invest in their business to further develop, so that they can prosper and improve their standard of living and support their family. To date the club has provided \$1,289.06 such business enterprise loans that have helped 57 individuals to date. Note 2.
- 100 Message in a Bottle and 100 Message in a Wallet which give the attending medics access to medical history of a patient in an emergency either at home or on go in a wallet, were distributed to local Chadwell Heath community Safe Neighbourhood Team (SNT).
- Club collected over 1000 pair of used and discarded prescription glasses, majority of these glasses were supplied by local branch of "Boots Opticians". We would like to thank Boots Opticians for their support in this initiative, which were supplied to Lions Club International who would then distribute them internationally to help disadvantage patients improve their vision.
- In 2023 statement of Income and Expenditure the Giving Tree initiative cost was stated as £1,428.15, this cost has been corrected and restated as £1,327.15. Note 4.

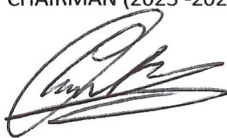

We are non-profit voluntary charity club, Seven Kings Lions Club (CIO) was registered with the Charities Commission number 1185513 on 26th September 2019 and has 3 trustees and 7 volunteers.

We raise funding through different sources i.e. Just Giving, Go Fund Me, Networking Events etc.

Our main projects that are:

- Giving Tree initiative this year identified disadvantaged children in the borough to whom we provide a gift that they wish for and may not otherwise receive. Club distributed approximately 150 Christmas Gift to children at total cost of £1,428.15.
- Kiva, where we provide business enterprises and personal support to individuals on a global basis as an interest free revolving loan allowing them to better their lives. To date the club has provided £700.00 enterprise loans
- Supply Message in a Bottle and Message in a Wallet which give the medics access to medical prescriptions for a patient in emergency either at home or in a wallet.
- Club has started a new Eye Sight initiative to collect pair of glasses and collected over 200 that were supplied to Lions Club International who would distribute them locally and internationally to help with improve vision for those in need.
- Grant received from the Lottery Community Fund was assigned to another food hub by 3Food4U instead of the one originally applied for. For this reason, the Lottery Community Fund had requested for the funds to be returned. 3Food4U are paying the funds back directly to Lottery Community Fund.

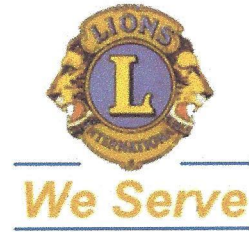
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- Kiva, where we provide business enterprises and personal support to individuals on a global basis as an interest free loan allowing them to better their lives.
