### CONSTITUTION

The Ellen Macnamara Memorial Foundation is constituted by a trust deed dated 10 July 2019 and registered with the Charity Commission with number 1185713.

### GOVERNANCE

The Foundation was established at the beginning of the previous period by a bequest from the will of Dr Ellen Macnamara. It currently has three trustees, listed on page 2, all of whom served throughout the year.

The trustees continued the appointment SPX Oxford Limited as the Foundation's accountants and Sheila Parry FCCA as Independent Examiner. Cazenove Capital Management continue to manage the Foundation's financial assets on a discretionary basis.

### OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

The object of the Foundation is to advance education in the field of Etruscan archaeology and related Italic studies.

The trustees envisage carrying out this object by sponsoring relevant academic research at an institution with an appropriate speciality. In order to do this over the long term, they need to build the Foundation's capital to a level where it can sustainably fund a researcher's stipend out of income without diminishing the capital fund in real terms.

So far, the Foundation's capital has been successfully increased from its original endowment from Dr Macnamara's will of £650,000 to nearly £900,000. Given advice that it would be sustainable to draw an income of around 3% this would support a stipend of £27,000, which is not yet sufficient to support a researcher at the post-doctoral level envisaged.

While the trustees would like to start work without further delay, realising this could jeopardise the long term future of the Foundation, they have resolved to be patient and continue to build the fund to a level where it can afford to fund its work in perpetuity.

The trustees have had regard to the Charity Commission's guidance on public benefit and believe that the Foundation will fulfil this when they bring it to a state where it can advance education.





### CONSTITUTION

The Ellen Macnamara Memorial Foundation is constituted by a trust deed dated 10 July 2019 and registered with the Charity Commission with number 1185713.

### GOVERNANCE

The Foundation was established at the beginning of the current period by a bequest from the will of Dr Ellen Macnamara. The will nominated three trustees, one family and two academic, all of whom had become unavailable by the time of her death, two having deceased and the remaining one having moved abroad. By a deed of appointment and retirement in 26 March 2018, James Macnamara, a nephew, and Sir Francis Portal, a godson, became trustees and subsequently appointed Freddy Macnamara, a great nephew. Having reestablished the family connection, the trustees will seek, in due course, to add relevant academic experience to their number.

The trustees have appointed SPX Oxford Limited as the Foundation's accountants and Sheila Parry FCCA as Independent Examiner. Cazenove Capital Management manage the Foundation's financial assets on a discretionary basis.

### OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

The object of the Foundation is to advance education in the field of Etruscan archaeology and related Italic studies.

In its initial period, the trustees have begun exploratory talks with a number of relevant academic institutions to develop plans to carry out this object. In accordance with Dr Macnamara's instructions, the trustees have transferred to the Tain and District Museum all those archaeological and historical books and artefacts the museum was prepared to accept from her collection at Keeper's Cottage, Carron Bridge, Ardgay, Sutherland.

In the meantime, they have invested her bequest through Cazenove Capital Management with the intention of growing it to an amount where the object could be carried out sustainably into the future. During the period, the Foundation's assets have been increased from the original bequest of £650,000 to £772,746, making significant progress towards this aim.

The trustees have had regard to the Charity Commission's guidance on public benefit and believe that the Foundation will fulfil this when they bring it to a state where it can advance education.






