TTOBs was founded in 2019 by Natasha Moore and Rachel Jordan with a mission statement

‘Offering an umbrella of emotional and pastoral support for ladies and families affected by cancer’

This pastoral support now extends to Stafford, Stoke, Burton, New Cross (Wolverhampton) and Cannock.

In 2019 Rachael and Natasha laid out their 5-year plan with key objectives for the organisation.

Overview

The charity had another very successful year providing support to members and those in the community touched by cancer.

The new 5-year plan discussed at the previous AGM has not yet been finalised, but the aim is for it to be completed this year.

Key Events

In September the charity’s incredible work was recognised by nominations at the Your Heroes Awards organised by Staffordshire University. Rachael was nominated for Charity Champion or Community Volunteer of the year and the charity itself was nominated for Community Group of the Year which they won.

In October the charity’s second retreat was held in Dysert, North Wales. Twenty-two members touched by cancer met for a *‘weekend of connection, relaxation and unforgettable moments’*. There were a wide range of activities including a Sound Bath Workshop, scenic walks, yoga sessions, dancing and paddle in the sea. This year’s retreat is currently being planned.

On the 31st October the charity celebrated its fifth anniversary - an incredible testament to the vision of Rachael and Tash. The milestone was marked by members at an afternoon tea at Cup a Cha.

In November there was an enjoyable weekend of charity runs at Alton Towers. The event was very successful and will take place again this year.

The charity's first wreath making event was held in December. Fuelled by mince pies and mulled wine members creative skills came to the fore and spectacular individual festive wreaths were created in a convivial atmosphere.

The fourth annual charity ball was held at the County Showground, Stafford in March and raised over £23,000.

Support Work

The charity provided chemo kits to Staffordshire and Wolverhampton hospitals.

In August, BBC news featured the 'Big Bertha' training kit being donated to Royal Wolverhampton NHS trust. The kit demonstrates how to carry out self-checks at home.

Every month at the meet and greet members are offered the opportunity to experience a different type of support including hypnotherapy and holistic wellbeing.

The charity is looking to purchase a moisture scanning device at a cost of £4250.

The mobile mammogram scanners will soon be delivered to the County Hospital.

1. Paul reported that he thought the AGM was good, reflecting on previous 5 year plan. The trustees can help with next 5 yr plan. The charity accomplished so much more than was originally planned. We need to be adventurous with the next plan.
2. **Update from chair of TToBs – Rachael Jordan.**
We would like to celebrate the 10 yr anniversary with a show which Rachel Miller will lead. This will not necessarily be to raise money but just a celebration.
3. **Ideas for next five-year plan**
Rachael reported that we would like to run a Podcast (idea came from Sammy-Jo). Rachael will research this over next 18 months, see what is engaging, build a podcast, needs marketing and broadcasting. TToBs do have a youtube channel which could be used. We would like to bank interviews to ensure we have material to publish and to launch in 5 years time. This may help to engage new members who currently seem to prefer social occasions. We currently have a 25 – 30% engagement rate.
Paul to help with a company he is working with.
4. **Social Occasions for members.**
We are arranging a visit to Love Clay which can accommodate 20 visitors.
Afternoon tea at Blackpool Tower in July
A second retreat will be organised to be held Spring/Summer time and will be more outdoor based. Rachael and Sammy-Jo have found a potential venue and will check its suitability and what local holistic therapies are available.
We are also looking to arrange a visit to Kirsty Bull's boutique in Perton.
5. Rachael updated the trustees on **Titties on Tour**. There was a well-received visit to Michelin. Rachael and Rachel took the new stand and goodie bags for the attendees. This was a hybrid presentation lasting 45 minutes. The staff named our new breast checking jacket Ada (previously known as Bertha).
Last week there was a MS Teams meeting with representatives from Drake Hall Prison. The prison would like 4 presentations in one day occurring 4 times a year.

All prisoners must be accommodated if any merchandise is taken. Gina reported that cancer does bring anxiety to prisoners. We would like to work with some of the prisoners to design posters/stickers to show women how to check themselves.

6. Collaborative Working with other Companies.

We would like to work with companies, especially around October (Breast Cancer Awareness Month) Ideas include, beer mats, milk stop, bag straps. We would like to research the web sites available where you can design merchandise which they publish for orders.

Paul to send links and he will also look at beer mats.

7. Other items discussed.

Rachael reported she would like to use the iPad to live stream meet and greets so that members who are unable to attend can take part and view the meeting. Gina will send Rachael some literature regarding checking breasts and use of the Ada training aid.

Bras and Scars will be revived and revamped to be used in the future.

Dr Liz O'Riordan who has a social media presence was discussed a good source of useful information.

TTOBs was founded in 2019 by Natasha Moore And Rachael Jordan to deliver holistic, emotional and practical support to ladies in Staffordshire when they have received a cancer diagnosis. This pastoral support has now been extended to the Burton and New Cross Hospital too.

In 2019 Rachael and Natasha laid out their 5 year plan with objectives for the organisation. The charity is now in its 4th year and the Trustees are delighted of the continuous progress made by all in delivering on that plan and are confident that TTOBs will continue to further grow and develop.

The lived experience of this organisation's Trustees, Committee members and Volunteers is used to identify opportunities to make a meaningful difference in the lives of the local women that approach us for help; each of whom are on their own individual and unique cancer journey.

During 2022 it was identified by the members of the group who have secondary cancers, that they would like an additional group facilitating to address/discuss their different holistic needs. With this feedback, the TTOB secondary group was created. The TTOB secondary group holds a monthly get together which is also very well attended. The members of this group also attend the main monthly meetings and events. This additional group demonstrates the charities commitment to further improve the lives of our members.

March 2023 saw the second TTOB ball take place at the County Show ground. Sarah Peter did a phenomenal job in facilitating the event for a 2nd time and an astonishing 26k was raised on the evening. This event was a fantastic evening and was thoroughly enjoyed by everyone who attended. The trustees would like to thank the volunteers on the evening for all their help ensuring the evening went smoothly. Following on from this success the third ball has been booked for March 2024.

The charity has a very close working relationship with the local hospital and its staff. It has come to life that the hospital unit would hugely benefit from having a portable ultrasound machine and a family room for the Breast Care Unit. Conversations are taking place between the hospital, committee members and Trustees to negotiate a donation.

As mentioned in the previous Trustee AGM report, there are still challenges that remain.

Wellbeing services are still underutilised even though these are regularly promoted at all monthly meetings. Moving forward, In October we will see the first weekend group retreat being held. With this event being a group gathering, we are hoping that the members will take up this retreat. This will be a fantastic opportunity for the ladies to enjoy some much deserved rest and recuperation and we look forward to hearing all about it.

The finances of the organisation ended 2022 in an even stronger position from the year previous at just over 34k. The financial management of these funds continues to be supervised competently according to the requirements placed upon us as Trustees. The day to day operational costs of the Charity still remained very modest in 2022, even with the charity expanding their geographical reach to the other extended areas of Staffordshire.

Looking forward to the year ahead, there are a number of well thought out monthly meetings, special events and social gatherings that have been planned. We Trustees would like to thank the SRUFC for their continued generosity and support in allowing the TTOB to use the clubhouse for their events.

TTOBs exists to offer pastoral, emotional and practical support to ladies in Staffordshire when they have received a cancer diagnosis.

The lived experience of this organisation's Trustees, Committee members and Volunteers is used to identify opportunities to make a meaningful difference in the lives of the local women that approach us for help; each of whom are on their own individual and unique cancer journey.

In 2019 Rachael and Natasha laid out their 5 year plan with objectives for our organisation. We are approximately half way through that journey and Trustees are proud of the progress made by all in delivering on that plan and are confident that TTOBs will continue to grow.

Growth will come not only in size and volume but more importantly with growth in the quality, in the value of the support we offer and in our experience in delivering it all effectively with compassion and empathy.

A milestone on that plan was achieved with the design, planting and opening of the TTOBs Memorial Garden on a plot donated by Stafford RUFC at their new home at Coopers Park in Stafford. Through the dedicated efforts of many on the Committee and other volunteers, the grand opening was attended by significant numbers of local people and attracted press coverage making even more people in the area aware of the activities and values of the Charity.

The clubhouse at SRUFC continued to be a welcome home for TTOBs throughout the year, not only hosting a variety of events but most importantly, the monthly support meetings which continue to develop with an ever wider range of external visiting speakers.

The postponement of the 2021 Annual TTOBs Gala Ball was reluctantly taken and although it would not return to the calendar until March 2022, significant efforts were required in 2021 to deliver this event. The Trustees are incredibly grateful to Sarah Peters and all those on the organising committee who worked so hard in 2021 to deliver what was a landmark event for the charity.

The finances of the organisation ended 2021 in a strong position, having increased the total value of fundraising and donations (income) throughout the year by 92% when compared to 2020, rising from around £10.5k to £14.5k.

The financial management of these funds continues to be supervised competently according to the requirements placed upon us as Trustees. Whilst the day to day operational costs of the Charity remained modest in 2021, the amount we were able to spend on delivering Wellbeing services and related activities to our diagnosed ladies and their families was effectively doubled when compared to 2020 and represents a significant achievement.

Another important accomplishment of the year is reflected in the fact that the amount we were able to allocate to the Secondary Fund increased from £1k in 2020 to £4k. This represents further growth in the scope and ambition of TTOBs and will help create memories and positive experiences in ways which will be sincerely felt by the ladies and families that are supported by TTOBs.

Despite the many successes in 2021 there are challenges which still remain.

An informal survey conducted early in 2021 identified that, amongst other things, many of the wellbeing services that we offer to diagnosed ladies are underutilised. The reasons cited for this included both a lack of awareness of what was available as well as the possible reluctance to ask for support that they didn't always 'feel that they deserved'.

It is crucial that Trustees, combined with Committee Members and Volunteers, work even harder in 2022 to address this disparity so that we can become even more adept at using our funds to improve and enrich the day to day experiences of our diagnosed ladies as we have been at raising the funds in the first place.

Throughout this year we have been able to increase the number of families assisted by around 25% and now support 100 families in the Staffordshire region.

Fundraising has continued and by all accounts there is money to spend as some of the planned events had to be paused or rearranged.

With the gift of a plot of land from our friends at Stafford Rugby Club a beautiful memorial garden has been first imagined and designed, has now been planted and created and awaits a suitable official grand opening just as soon as circumstances allow.

I've only seen a few pictures so far but I know that it's going to be a really beneficial focal point to both publicly and also privately remember those who you have all worked so hard to support.

The effects of COVID on where we all hoped the charity would be by now should not be underestimated.

The advent of lock down for almost all of us and shielding for some of us has meant that the nature of the support and services offered had to change. However, although it did change it has never stopped.

Regular monthly zoom meetings have been held for both small and large groups so that, as much as possible, connections and friendships are maintained and so that support is uninterrupted.

In fact it may be that once we are out the other side of this long pandemic, we may find that COVID has taught us as a charity several things. For example, many of us will feel that nothing will beat a face-to face meeting, seeing friends for a coffee and a catch up and even a cry. However, it may be that some of the people you all work so hard to support feel that, at different stages in their cancer journey, that they might actually prefer to stay home and catch up on a laptop and a zoom meeting that we've all had to learn to get used to.

If there are lessons like this , and others to learn then we should be ready to listen.

The next 12 months brings many opportunities and only some will be affected by the rate of opening up after lockdown.

We have a Grand opening for the memorial garden to look forward to and off course there's a Gala ball that will need planning but however long restrictions apply we aim to investigate and develop new funding streams such as grant applications and other donations.

I would like to thank everyone involved with TTOBs for both their patience during a tumultuous 12 months and for their continued dedication and hardwork in supporting the many families who reach out for your help
