This is the Trustees' report for Karam Bhoomi Foundation ("the Charity"), a charity registered with the Charity Commission for England and Wales, charity number 1186163, on 5 November 2019 in England. These financials are the fifth to be submitted by the Charity since its establishment in 2019 and this report covers the period from 1 January 2024 until 31 December 2024 ("the Reporting Period").

The Charity is managed by three trustees – Kaizarin Kalifa, as the Chair, along with Anju Lama Chughtai and Gabriela Collins – and operates with the primary purpose of supporting the needy and relieving poverty by supporting education and welfare of underprivileged children and their families in India. During the Reporting Period, the Charity did this by continuing to work with its partner An Initiative to Touch Your Soul (AITYS), whose aims are compatible with those of the Charity. AITYS is an all-volunteer charitable trust based in India that provides education sponsorship for children, infrastructure support for schools and free medical camps for villagers in designated locations in Uttarakhand, a northern state in India bordering China.

Karam Bhoomi's strategy during 2024 was to continue to increase awareness of the Charity and its causes, and raise funds by attracting supporters whose views were aligned to those of the Charity.

While the Charity did not actively organise fund raising events during the reporting period, it raised £3,854 through regular monthly and one-off personal donations. This, coupled with a surplus balance of £825 from the previous year, enabled the Charity to donate £3,100 to AITYS for its charitable cause of supporting projects in the deprived regions of Uttarakhand, a northern Indian state. At the end of the year, the charity had a credit bank balance of £1,371, after accounting for costs.

The Charity has a website which is elaborate and gives people accessing the website more information about the charity and should increase people's awareness. The website facilitates online donations, one off or regular.

The charity is set up to collect HMRC Gift Aid for its contributions, where it applies to donors.

The charity did not have a deficit during the Reporting Period.

The Charity is managed by three trustees – Kaizarin Kalifa, as the Chair, along with Anju Lama Chughtai and Gabriela Collins – and operates with the primary purpose of supporting the needy and relieving poverty by supporting education and welfare of underprivileged children and their families in India. During the Reporting Period, the Charity did this by continuing to work with its partner An Initiative to Touch Your Soul (AITYS), whose aims are compatible with those of the Charity. AITYS is an all volunteer charitable trust based in India that provides education sponsorship for children, infrastructure support for schools and free medical camps for villagers in designated locations in Uttarakhand, a northern state in India bordering China.

Karam Bhoomi's strategy during 2023 was to continue to increase awareness of the Charity and its causes and raise funds by attracting supporters whose views were aligned to those of the Charity. As in previous years, opportunities to raise funds during 2023 were limited due to the challenging domestic economic environment which made it difficult to justify fund raising events for overseas causes.

While the Charity did not actively organise fund raising events during the reporting period, it raised £680 through personal donations. This, coupled with a surplus balance of £3,955 from the previous year, enabled the Charity to donate £3,800 to AITYS for its charitable cause of supporting projects in the deprived regions of Uttarakhand, a northern Indian state.

At the end of the year, the charity had a credit bank balance of £825.

The charity has a website which is elaborate and gives people accessing the website more information about the charity and should increase people's awareness. The website facilitates online donations, one off or regular.

The charity is set up to collect HMRC Gift Aid for its contributions, where it applies to donors.

The charity did not have a deficit during the Reporting Period.

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The Charity is managed by three trustees – Kaizarin Kalifa, as the Chair, along with Anju Lama Chughtai and Gabriela Collins – and operates with the primary purpose of supporting the needy and relieving poverty by supporting education and welfare of underprivileged children and their families in India. During the Reporting Period, the Charity did this by continuing to work with its partner An Initiative to Touch Your Soul (AITYS), whose aims are compatible with those of the Charity. AITYS is an all volunteer charitable trust based in India that provides education sponsorship for children, infrastructure support for schools and free medical camps for villagers in designated locations in Uttarakhand, a northern state in India bordering China.

As a relatively new charity, Karam Bhoomi's strategy during 2022 was to continue to increase awareness of the Charity and its causes, and raise funds by attracting supporters whose views were aligned to those of the Charity. As in 2020 & 2021, opportunities to raise funds during 2022 were limited due to the challenging domestic economic environment which made it difficult to justify fund raising events for overseas causes.

Nevertheless, the Charity managed to raise approximately £10,000 (compared to £16,990 in 2021) primarily through:

- personal donations of £7,490, and
- a fund raising charity dinner on 5 November 2022 aimed at
 - (i) bringing together dedicated supporters and attracting new supporters; and (ii) using the event to re-emphasise the objectives and achievements of the charity.The event raised £2,541 after costs which included donations of £1,060.

Of the proceeds received by the charity during the year, an amount of £7,210 was sent to AITYS for its charitable cause of supporting projects to build class rooms and toilet facilities for schools in the deprived regions of Uttarakhand, a northern Indian state.

At the end of the year, the charity had a credit bank balance of £3,955.

The charity has an established website which is elaborate and gives people accessing the website more information about the charity and should increase people's awareness. The website facilitates online donations, one off or regular.

The charity is set up to collect HMRC Gift Aid for its contributions, where it applies to donors.

The charity did not have a deficit during the Reporting Period.

The Charity is managed by three trustees – Kaizarin Kalifa, as the Chair, along with Anju Lama Chguhtai and Gabriela Collins – and operates with the primary purpose of supporting the needy and relieving poverty by supporting education and welfare of underprivileged children and their families in India. During the Reporting Period, the Charity did this by continuing to work with its partner An Initiative to Touch Your Soul (AITYS), whose aims are compatible with those of the Charity. AITYS is an all volunteer charitable trust based in India that provides education sponsorship for children, infrastructure support for schools and free medical camps for villagers in designated locations in Uttarakhand, a northern state in India bordering China.

As a relatively new charity, Karam Bhoomi's strategy during 2021 was primarily to increase awareness of the Charity and its causes, and raise funds by attracting supporters whose views were aligned to those of the Charity. As in 2020, opportunities to do so during 2021 were limited due to sporadic lockdowns and disruptions caused by coronavirus.

Nevertheless, the Charity managed to raise £16,900 (compared to £6000 in 2020) through:

- personal donations of varying sizes, the biggest of which was £5000; and
- a raffle in which the prize was two centre court Wimbledon seats during the second week of the tournament.

Of the proceeds received by the charity £15,000 was sent to AITYS for its charitable cause of supporting the needy in the north Indian state of Uttarakhand, where the people were still recovering from the Covid crisis, and refurbishing dilapidated schools in the area.

During the year the charity updated its website. The website is now more elaborate and gives people accessing the website more information about the charity and should increase people's awareness. The next objective is to develop the website to facilitate online donations, one off or regular.

The charity is now also set up to collect HMRC Gift Aid for its contributions, where it applies to donors.

The charity did not have a deficit during the Reporting Period.

This is the Trustees' report for Karam Bhoomi Foundation ("the Charity"), a charity registered with the Charity Commission for England and Wales, charity number 1186163, on 5 November 2019 in England. These financials are first submitted by the Charity since its establishment and the report covers the period from 5 November 2019 until 31 December 2020 ("the Reporting Period").

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As a newly established charity, during 2019/20 its strategy was to increase awareness of the Charity and its causes, and raise funds by attracting supporters whose views were aligned to those of the Charity. Opportunities to do so were limited due to lockdowns and disruptions caused by coronavirus during much of 2020. Nevertheless, the Charity managed to raise over £6000 through personal donations and a bingo fund raising event and which enabled it to contribute £5000 to AITYS. These monies were distributed by AITYS to support families in Uttarakhand who were struggling to survive because their livelihoods had been disrupted by loss of earnings and jobs due to the coronavirus crisis.

The charity did not have a deficit during the Reporting Period.

The Charity is working to set up a website which should further increase awareness of the Charity and facilitate online donations. The Charity has yet to be registered for HMRC gift aid and this remains one of the objectives going forward.
