

We have continued to work with Action Against Cancer and made a substantial donation to them to support a clinical trial looking at Tumour Heterogeneity in TNBC patients. This trial and research conducted will be able to identify new, tailor made treatment approaches and potentially save countless lives. We have continued to pay for holistic treatments for women going through treatment for TNBC and arranged care packages for their family members. By using our social media platforms we have continued to raise awareness of this type of breast cancer, and sign post to other organisations if required.

The trials and research conducted has focused on predicting behaviour of cancer cells and identifying which individuals are more likely to be at risk from metastasis. This research could potentially save countless lives and is one of our main charitable objectives as set out in our Governing Document. We continue to receive donations through the Paypal Giving Fund and through donations in loving memory of family members. 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
