Area of Benefit:	To support the charitable work of West London Synagogue and other charitable purposes.
Trustees' Powers:	In accordance with the Trust Deed dated 20 March 2018 the Trustees' have powers to invest the Trusts' assets at their discretion.
Aims and Organisation:	The Trustees' arrange for the collection and receipt of the donations and decide to what extent and for what purpose or purposes monies are to be applied. The Trustees ensure that there are sufficient donations to meet the needs of the Trust.
Review of Progress and Activities:	On 1st March 2022, Heidi Paradise and Blair Jacobson were appointed as additional trustees. Following the initial donation of £100 and the donation of £5,000 in April 2019, no further donations have been received until 14th April 2022 when a grant of £100,000 was made to the Trust. The Trustees interviewed several potential investment managers but deferred a decision to invest because of the volatility of the market. As no grants were made, the only expenditure during the year therefore related to bank charges.
