<p>During this reporting period, Magic Aid had continued to make a small donation towards the scholarships of beneficiaries/orphans who would not have pursued their education owing to financial hardship caused by poverty.</p> <p>Magic Aid had also run a fundraising campaign to raise just over £2000 through crowdfunding (GoFundMe) to contribute towards the cost of a major spinal surgery of one benefit of its beneficiaries.</p> <p>Magic Aid shipped apparel to Togo and distributed them to poorest patients in children hospital</p> <p>The trustees have had regard to the guidance issued by the Charity Commission on public benefit.</p>
