The charity is a **Charitable Incorporated Organisation (CIO)** governed by its **constitution dated 18 November 2019**.

The objects of the charity are:

PROVIDING GRANTS, ITEMS AND OTHER METHODS OF SUPPORT TO ADVANCE THE EDUCATION OF PRIMARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOL CHILDREN. 2. AWARDING TO SUCH PERSONS SCHOLARSHIPS, MAINTENANCE ALLOWANCES OR GRANTS TENABLE AT ANY UNIVERSITY, COLLEGE OR INSTITUTION OF HIGHER OR FURTHER EDUCATION. 3. PROVIDING THEIR EDUCATION (INCLUDING THE STUDY OF MUSIC OR OTHER ARTS), TO UNDERTAKE TRAVEL IN FURTHERANCE OF THAT EDUCATION OR TO PREPARE FOR ENTRY TO ANY OCCUPATION, TRADE OR PROFESSION ON LEAVING ANY EDUCATIONAL ESTABLISHMENT.

During the year, the charity carried out research activities in furtherance of these objects.

The trustees have had due regard to the Charity Commission's guidance on public benefit and consider that the charity's activities have provided public benefit in furtherance of its charitable purposes.

The trustees intend to continue the charity's activities in line with its stated objects during the coming year.




