Activities: We advance animal welfare of cats and dogs. We provide foster homes and we identify suitable permanent homes in the UK for unwanted/abandoned/lost/stray domestic animals from abroad, particularly from Greece. We provide financial aid, through fundraising, for medical care, including neutering and for transport to the UK, according to current legislation; we raise awareness of the public.

- **achievements and performance**

In the period **01/04/2024 to 31/03/2025**, we have rehomed 15 dogs and 8 cats from Greece.

Where appropriate, we have used our charity-registered PetTrac account to register the microchips in the UK as soon as the dog/cat arrives. Thus, many of our adopted pets enjoy dual registration to the new adopter and to the Charity.

We are registered with the Government GATEWAY IPAFFS (import-of-products-animals-food-and-feed-system) for the Health Certificates and the EORI (Economic Operator Registration and Identification) for the Import Tax.

- **Financial review**

We operated on a cost recovery basis, that is, we aimed to recover as much as possible of the costs associated with transport, import fees and medical costs associated with each rescue animal, if these have covered by us, through a voluntary adoption fee. Many of these are paid directly by the adopter to the relevant entity. Increased transport costs mean that we are often unable recover all of the costs via the adoption fee. Payments are handled by the treasurer or the chair, with oversight by the chair, via our dedicated Charity Bank Account. The chair has made some payments for the transport and import fees with approval of the treasurer. We have obtained invoices for our payments to the transporter and from the microchip database. We have fundraised through informal, donation-based dog sitting for friends/neighbours; we have received the occasional spontaneous donation. All financial transactions are through our dedicated Charity Bank account; donations are deposited directly there, so there is full transparency of income and expenses. Our income in the reporting period has been £2,475 and the expenses have been £3663,63.

In the period **01/04/2023 to 31/03/2024**, we have rehomed 11 dogs from Greece, and 1 cat, on a transport cost recovery basis. This is an average of one rescue pet per month. One of the rehomed dogs was a dog adopted from us 5 years ago and re-rehomed through our Rescue Back-Up pledge.

We have used our charity-registered PetTrac account to register the microchips in the UK as soon as the dogs arrive. Thus, our adopted dogs enjoy dual registration to the new adopter and to the Charity.

We are registered with the Government GATEWAY IPAFFS and the EORI (Economic Operator Registration and Identification).

- **Financial review**

We operated on a cost recovery basis, that is, we aimed to recover as much as possible of the transport, import fees and medical costs associated with each rescue animal, through a voluntary adoption fee. Increased transport costs mean that we are unable to routinely recover all of the costs via the adoption fee. Payments are handled by the treasurer, with oversight by the chair. The chair has made some payments for the transport and import fees with approval of the treasurer. We have obtained invoices for our payments to the transporter and from the microchip database. We have fundraised through informal, donation-based dog sitting for friends/neighbours; we have received the occasional spontaneous donation. The costs of fostering while looking for a suitable adopter are higher this year due to slower adoptions (post-COVID there is a flood of rescues) but these have been covered by volunteering. All financial transactions are through a dedicated Charity Bank account; donations are deposited directly there. Our income in the reporting period has been £5,878.88 and the expenses have been £4,934.34.

We have a charity PetTrac account to register the microchips in the UK as soon as the dogs arrive. Our adopted dogs have dual registration to the new adopter and to the Charity. We are registered with the Government GATEWAY IPAFFS and the EORI (Economic Operator Registration and Identification).

2 of our Trustees will retire in the next reporting period and we hope that they will be re-elected. We have secured one more Trustee that will come on board in the next financial period.

- **Financial review**

We operated on a cost recovery basis, that is, we aimed to recover as much as possible of the transport, import and medical costs associated with each rescue animal, through a voluntary adoption fee. Increased transport costs mean that we are unable to recover all of the costs via the adoption fee. Payments are handled by the treasurer, with oversight by the chair. Occasionally, payments are made by the chair after discussion and approval of the treasurer. We have obtained invoices for our payments to the transporter. We have fundraised through informal, donation-based dog sitting for friends/neighbours; we have received the occasional spontaneous donation. The costs of fostering while looking for a suitable adopter are higher this year due to slower adoptions (post-COVID there is a flood of rescues) but these have been covered by volunteering. All financial transactions are through a dedicated Charity Bank account; donations are deposited directly there. Our income in the reporting period has been £5925 and the expenses have been £6075 leaving us with a small deficit which we have covered in the next financial period.

We have a charity PetTrac account to register the microchips in the UK as soon as the dogs arrive. Our adopted dogs have dual registration to the new adopter and to the Charity.

We are registered with the Government GATEWAY IPAFFS and the EORI (Economic Operator Registration and Identification).

We have prepared an educational booklet explaining how to care for your rescue dog.

- We have held one AGM on October 3rd, 2021 which had an agenda and was minuted.

- **Financial review**

We operated on a cost recovery basis, that is, we aimed to recover as much as possible of the transport, import and medical costs associated with each rescue animal, through a voluntary adoption fee. Payments are handled by the treasurer, with oversight by the chair. We have obtained invoices for our payments. A Charity Bank account was opened with Barclays at 24th April 2021 and all financial transactions are through this dedicated Charity Bank account; donations are deposited directly there. We have fundraised through informal, donation-based dog sitting for friends/neighbours and sporting events (Fred Whitton cycle ride); we

have received the occasional spontaneous donation. Our income in the reporting period has been £6,498 and the expenses have been £4,328, leaving us with a small positive balanced to ensure the sustainability of our activities.

In the period **18/11/2019 to 31/03/2021**, we have rehomed 18 dogs and 1 cat from Greece, on a transport cost recovery basis.

We have opened a charity PetTrac account to register the microchips in the UK as soon as the dogs arrive. Most adopted dogs now have dual registration to the new adopter and to the Charity.

We have obtained an agreement to issue TRACES for dogs to travel from Frontizo and Halkidiki Animal Rescue. Once the import rules changed (due to Brexit) we have complied with the new rules to import dogs, including presenting Health Certificates, paying VAT and registering with Government GATEWAY IPAFFS and the EORI (Economic Operator Registration and Identification).

We have prepared an educational booklet explaining how to care for your rescue dog.

We have prepared a new logo (to be implemented).

Both AGM had an agenda and were are minuted. In the second AGM we endorsed two changes in Trustee composition. The tenure of Rebecca Ellison and Amanda Barrott naturally ended on 18th November 2019. Rebecca was unanimously re-appointed for a further 3 years. Amanda Barrott did not wish to be re-appointed and her termination as a Trustee was accepted. The change was recorded to the Charity Commission website before preparing this report.

- Financial review

We operated on a cost recovery basis, that is, we aimed to recover as much as possible from the transport, import and medical costs through an adoption fee. We obtained invoices for our costs wherever possible. Our Charity Bank account was opened with Barclays on 24th April 2021, and details have been updated on the Charity Commission Website before preparing this report. Our balance at the end of the reporting period was £2,315. We have fundraised through sales jams (income [£521.70](#)), informal and donation based dog sitting for friends/neighbours, £285) and have received the occasional spontaneous donation (£160). Our outgoing donations to other rescue organisations were [£152.50](#).
