### **Governing document**

Salaam Foundation UK refers to the charity incorporated organisation with a governing document known as CIO Association incorporated on 21 November 2019 as amended on 02 December 2019.

### **Responsibilities of Trustees**

The annual report and financial statements are prepared according to the relevant law and approved by the trustees.

The trustees keep adequate accounting records and they show and explain our transactions. The records also disclose our financial position with reasonable accuracy at any time and enable trustees to ensure that the financial statements comply with Charity Commission Statement of Recommended Practice (SORP) 2015.

### **Grant Making Policies**

#### Ramadan Project in Pakistan

In the year 2023-2024, the Salaam Foundation UK distributed food packs to the needy, relieving them of the stress of wondering where their next meal would come from. The foundation strongly believes that providing food to those in need is a crucial step towards alleviating poverty. Therefore, their primary objective is to aid and strengthen organizations that supply food packs to underprivileged families in deprived regions.

### Achievements and Performance

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During the Holy month of Ramadan, we provided aid to deserving families. Our support came in the form of food parcels, which enabled them to have nourishing meals to break their fasts with. In total, we distributed close to 100 food packs containing essential items, which helped to ease their burden during this sacred time. We owe this success to the kindness and generosity of our donors, who contributed towards this cause.
