5 Accounting policy

a) Basis of the preparation of the accounts

The financial statements have been prepared on a Receipts & Payments basis which summarises the movement of cash in and out of the organisation, in this context 'cash' includes cash equivalents, such as bank accounts where cash can be readily available to pay debts as they fall due. This format of accounts is available to non-company charities with gross income of £250,000 or less.

b) Income and expenditure has been analyzed in the accounts using natural classification.

The charity maintains an unrestricted fund which represents funds which are expendable at the discretion of the trustees in furtherance of the objects of the charity. Unrestricted funds may arise from general donations, grants of a general nature, fees for service provision and payment for service delivery contracts.

Restricted funds may be provided to the charity for particular purposes and may only be spent for the purposes for which they were given.

Any balance remaining outstanding on a restricted fund at the end of the year is carried forward as a balance on the fund,

unless permission has been given by the funder to remove the restriction on the balance outstanding.

Restricted funds will arise from grants and donations given to the charity for a specific reasons.

d) The trustees confirm, in accordance with the Charitable Incorporated Organisations (General) Regulations 2012, that at the end the CIO did not have any outstanding guarantees to third parties nor any debts secured on assets of the CIO.

6 Trustee benefits, payments and expenses

There were no payments, remuneration or expenses made to the trustees during the period.

7 Transfer of Charity

Kids Kabin - Lord Deramore's Primary School Wrap-around Childcare Provision CIO was setup by the Lord Deramore's Primary School to take over the running of the wrap around care facility that had being formerly run by Lord Deramore's Out of School Club (Charity number 1002056) a charity run by volunteer parents using the facility since 1990, but due to stresses involved in running the club it was decided to approach the school it served for help. It was agreed that they would take over as a new CIO and all funds i.e £52066 would be transferred.
