Summary of the purposes of the charity as set out in its governing document	Para 1.17	<p>The purpose of Clwb Twm is to provide safe, affordable, accessible after school childcare for pupils of Ysgol Twm o'r Nant, offering a range of activities. We hope to support, single parents, working families and those in education and training.</p> <p>We aim to provide an environment in which children feel comfortable, happy and secure and are allowed to develop to their full potential.</p> <p>We aim to cultivate learning through play and creative activities to help children to develop personal, social and emotional, language and literacy, intellectual, creative and physical skills in order that they may become independent individuals.</p>

Para 1.17 and 1.19	<p>Clwb Twm is located in Ysgol Twm o'r Nant, Denbigh. The club has been running for over 20 years. The Club is a registered charity run by a management committee of Volunteers. The Club relies on a mixture of grant funding and fees. The Club provides a high-quality service through the medium of Welsh. However, not all the children come from Welsh speaking backgrounds. Clwb Twm is registered with Care Inspectorate Wales (CIW) as an after school cub for 56 children age 3-11, however this has been increased to 64 at the end of 2022. The Clwb is</p>

		<p>open every school day from 3pm to 5.30 pm. The Clwb is also a member of Cymru Kids Clubs. It is run by a committed and motivated team of staff and voluntary committee. It also offers every child of Ysgol Twm or Nant the opportunity to attend, irrespective of their needs, colour, language, religion, social economy background or family circumstances. The service provides a friendly, fun and stimulating environment for all who attend irrespective of their culture, abilities or social status, while meeting the social, physical, intellectual, creative and emotional needs of all the children and recognising the individual needs of each child.</p>

The profit for the financial year was £17454.14 however, a grant of £6981 was paid into the account in January and was not spent during the financial year, therefore the true profit for the year was £10472.87

The account balances will be reviewed during the financial year and any surplus in the Current Account will be transferred into the Reserves Account.
