



We have been raising funds through charity events, all limited through the Cost Of Living Crisis.

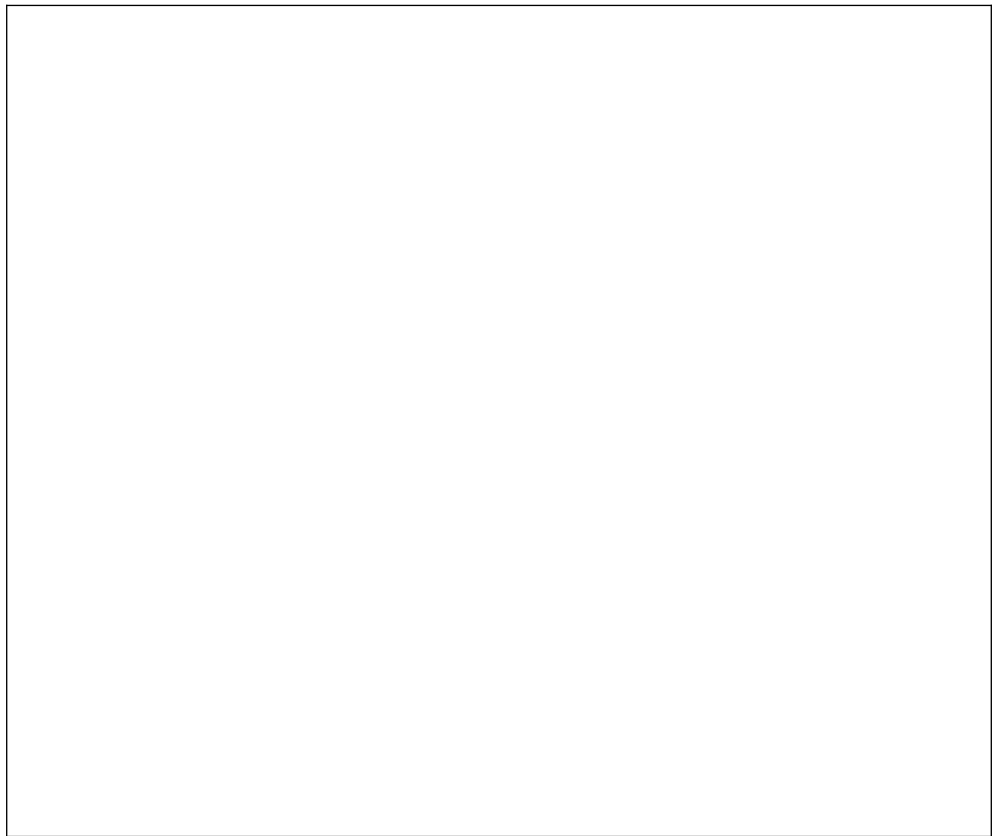
