Para 1.17 and 1.19	It is a relatively new trust in its infancy. Trust's goal is to start a STEM educational institute at a graduate level in Pakistan. However, before the trust could start that it needs to go through multiple administrative hurdles in Pakistan. After multiple visits to Pakistan to see various officials at personal expense trust have finally achieved registered in Pakistan with the ministry of interior, what it means is that the trust could operate in Pakistan. We applied for this registration in Nov 2020 and got our registration in early months of 2022. This was a mandatory process for a foreign trust to work in Pakistan. At present we are going through various other administrative e.g. trust's recognition as NPO in Pakistan. This is again a very lengthy process. Please keep in mind that nothing moves according to the plan in Pakistan and you need a patience of an elephant.

Review of the charity's financial position at the end of the period	Para 1.21	<p>At the end of this reporting period, the trust's income was £ 20. and expenditure £ 0. The income of £ 20 was donated by the trustees to keep the trust bank account open. Essentially the trustees have been bearing all the travel and other expenses of running around to/ within Pakistan, hence there is no trust expenditure. We are trying to full fill all the legal and administrative requirements in Pakistan before we can start to build the institute. The charity's financial position is good. We have no loans or debts. As yet the trust does not own any property except what is in our bank a/c. The trust does not employ any staff to reduce the expenses. The work is done voluntarily by the trustees especially Dr U Ali who is the national lead trustee for all the developments in Pakistan. He was involved in meetings with the British High Commission in Pakistan to muster support for the trust's project. He leads the trust's application for NPO recognition and ongoing land selection and developments in Pakistan etc and have made a significant positive impact and progress.</p>

Once we overcome all the legal requirements of the trust in Pakistan, only then the trustees hope to donate large sums of money to the trust to start building the institute in Pakistan.
