Salford Mental Health Forum is a charity led by mental health service users and carers that is committed to ensuring that people who use mental health services can shape and design them.

We aim to run regular forum meetings for mental health service users to discuss their experiences and give opportunities to feedback and shape public services.

In providing these activities the charities trustees have complied with the duty in section 4 of the Charities Act 2006 and have given due regard to the public benefit guidance published by the Charity Commission.

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the year

Salford Mental Health Forum (SMHF) unfortunately had to suspend meetings due to ill health of volunteers delivering the sessions, as a replacement coordinator was not found.

SMHF members have continued to work with other groups to support the mental health of people in Salford.

We aim to have a meeting next year to discuss the future of the organisation.

Section E Financial review

Brief statement of the charity's policy on reserves

The trustees aimed to end the year with free reserves of around £3500. We currently have free reserves of £3866. Due to a fluctuation in income and expenditure over the past three years we decided to set a monetary amount rather than several months operating costs.

This fund acts as a contingency in the event of a sudden reduction in income, to protect the future operation of the organisation from the effects of unforeseen variations in its income and expenditure. It also sets aside seed funding for projects developed by members of the forum to meet the charitable objectives of the charity for the benefit of the public.
