Support and awareness were provided to many new persons through Baby loss Awareness week, and we continued to lead the way locally for the awareness week with the organising of the Wave of Light Service and working with the local authority on acknowledgment of the week.

As trustees during this time, we also go above and beyond with awareness of stillbirth with publicity throughout the week in the media and raising further funds to support research.



