During 2023 the church's current address continues to be temporarily (this is a hotel which we rent by the hour only on Sundays for worship and we are only allowed the space for this activity). The previous address was retrieved by the Landlord for sale. We have been struggling to find a suitable location for the church and are still viewing properties for suitability and affordability. In the mean time the food bank has also been temporarily discontinued. It will be reopened as soon as a suitable accommodation is found for the church. We are however more hopeful of finding a place as some locations have become available. All other church activities which involve the general public will return to previous status upon us finding appropriate accommodation.

The Bishop's health after a stroke continues to improve and he is still managing the church.

We have also carried out interviews for 2 new trustees.

In the mean time the food bank has also been temporarily discontinued. It will be reopened as soon as a suitable accommodation is found for the church.

All other church activities which involve the general public will return to previous status upon us finding appropriate accommodation.

Along with our accommodation issues our bishop sustained a stroke and was very ill as a result, however he has recovered to a stage where he has returned to manage the church. We also lost 2 trustees and are currently in the process of n appointing new ones.

Currently it serves approximately 50 people who attend the foodbank at the church weekly on a Tuesday, some of who have families including children to benefit from the food. Food is obtained from Fareshare food charity, located in Birmingham at a minimal cost, which the church pays.

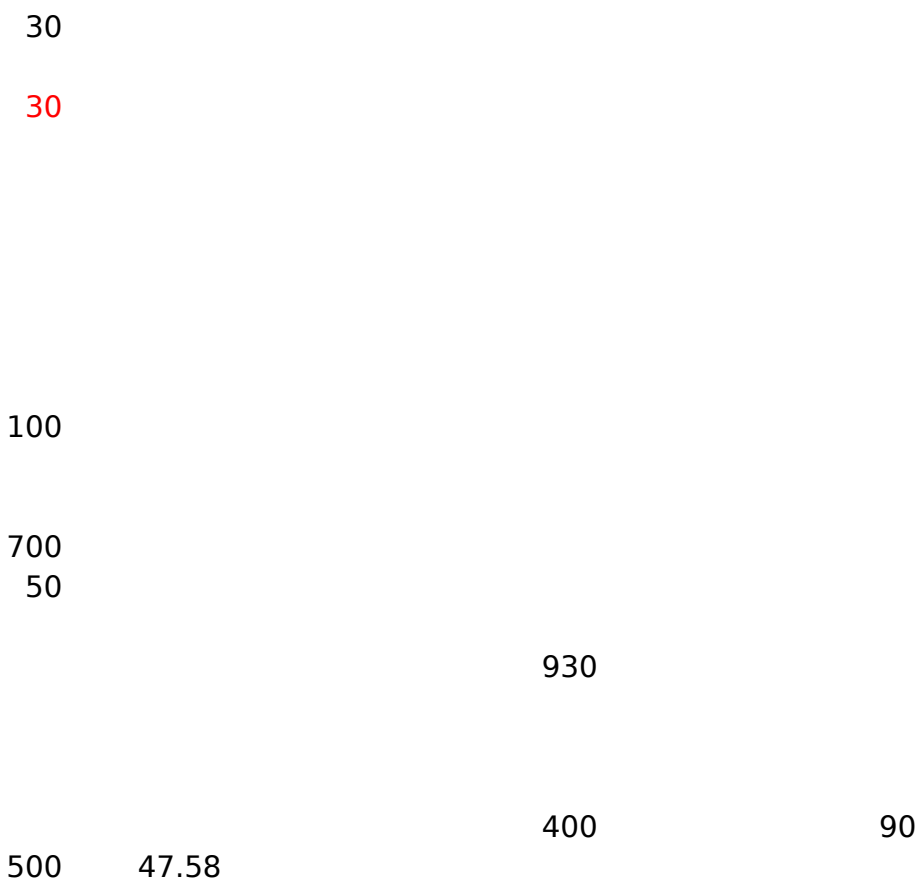
