DURING THE PERIOD, THE CHARTY SECURED INCOME FROM THE PUBLIC OF £105,752 OF WHICH £105,602 WERE DONATIONS AND £150 WERE SALE INCOME FROM WATER. THE CHARITY EXPENDED £92,296 OF WHICH GRANTS WERE £88,435. THIS RESULTED IN A SURPLUS OF £13,456 FOR THE PERIOD WHICH WAS ADDED TO PRIOR YEAR SURPLUS TO GIVE TOTAL SURPLUS FUNDS AS £71,364 WHICH WILL BE RETAINED FOR FUTURE CHARITABLE EXPENDITURE IN THE COMING YEAR. THE TRUSTEES HAVE A POLICY NOT TO HOLD ANY RESERVES APART FROM FUNDS THAT ARE COMMITTED FOR FUTURE CHARITABLE EXPENDITURE AND PAYMENT OF LIABILITIES.


