The trustees and stakeholders held a planning and prayer meeting on the 25th of June, 2023 on Google Meet platform and reviewed the progress of the Charity, which include the following:

- The appointment of an Ad hoc Solicitor to advise on the procedure for bringing into the UK a Minister of Religion from CCCI Headquarters in Nigeria, to serve as Pastor-in-Charge of the UK church.
- A decision was made to locate the UK church primarily outside London, where accommodation would be affordable.
- The trustees agreed to continue with the current monthly prayer meeting using Google-Meet virtual platform.
- Arrangement to acquire CCCI UK office and residential property has been intensified.
- Preparation has been on-going for the launch of CCCI outreach event in London: "Morning Dew" by the Presiding Bishop Emmah Isong in the next couple of years

CHARITY EVENT.

CCCI organised a charity dinner at the Bexleyheath Delta Hotel by Marriotts on Thursday 1st December 2022. This event is organised in partnership with the Full Gospel Businessmen UK & Ireland.




