In preparing those financial statements, the trustees are required to:-


- (a) select suitable accounting policies and apply them consistently

**1 ACCOUNTING POLICIES**

**Accounting convention**

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention, with the exception of investments, which are included at market value, as modified by the revaluation of certain assets and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008), the Charities Act 2011 and the requirements of the Statement of Recommended Practice, Accounting and Reporting by Charities.

**Exemption from preparing a cash flow statement**

Exemption has been taken from preparing a cash flow statement on the grounds that the charity qualifies as a small charity.

**Incoming resources**

All incoming resources are included on the Statement of Financial Activities when the charity is legally entitled to the income and the amount can be qualified with reasonable accuracy.

**Resources expended**

Expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis and has been classified under headings that aggregate all cost related to the category. Where costs cannot be directly attributed to particular headings, they have been allocated to activities on a basis consistent with the use of resources. Grants offered subject to conditions, which have not been met at the year end date, are noted as a commitment but not accrued as expenditure.

**Investments**

Fixed asset investments are stated at market value.

For investments where no such value is readily ascertainable, assets are stated at cost less provision for diminution in value.

All investment assets are UK based unless otherwise stated.

Unrealised gains and losses on investments are charged to the statement of financial activities in the year in which they arise.
