School facility improvements are also made. Replacing floors, painting classrooms, improving toilets and water supplies. Developing irrigation systems for watering vegetable gardens is also essential.</b></p> <p><b>In Cambodia we focus on developing family vegetable gardens.</b></p> <p><b>In Tanzania we have started a programme of teaching women to make reusable sanitary pads. Girls and women often have to miss school or work when they menstruate. Washable pads enable women and girls to manage their periods and empower them to fully develop their capabilities.</b></p> <p><b>We aim to ensure that our work is fully sustainable.</b></p> <p><b>The communities we support are fully engaged in our work and appreciate our endeavour.</b></p>
