Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the year

We held singing sessions for children on Monday evenings. These were typically attended by 35 – 45 children. There was good growth in the group in 2023 with a successful advertising and recruitment campaign.

We held concerts in July and at Christmas. Both were well attended with an audience of approx 150 people that helped us to raise funds to support the group and help keep costs down to a minimum (still just £10 per half-term per child).

The account balance at year end was £2,693 which is an increase of £297 relative to the balance of £2,396 at the beginning of the year.


