The activities of the charity are fundraising by membership subscription, events, grant applications, and general donations. In planning their activities for the year, the Trustees have considered the Charity Commission's guidance on public benefit.

Achievements and Performance

The Friends was constituted as a Charitable Incorporated Organisation on 5 February 2020 by adopting the Charity Commission's 'Foundation Model' model governing document. It was registered at the Charity Commission on 25 February 2020. The governing document is available at <https://tevershamfriends.org/documents>.

In the fifth year of operation, the Friends has raised £13,000 and spent £20,000 in a grant to All Saints PCC and £600 in architect's fees. The Trustees maintained the website to promote the activity of the Friends. The costs of the website are borne *ex gratia* by a Trustee.

There have been no related parties transactions.

Financial Review

The charity generated a loss of **£7,600** in the year to 31 December 2024. Total income was **£13,000**. Total expenditure was **£20,600**. There were no operating expenses, with other expenses (website, postage, etc.) covered *ex gratia* by the Trustees themselves.

The Trustees have not considered it necessary to set a formal level of reserve which the Charity is required to maintain. The level of grant expenditure is entirely at the discretion of the Trustees and is set with reference to annual income. The nature of the Charity's activities is such that was possible to maintain sufficient funds in the bank to meet any liabilities as they fell due.

The Trustees have considered the risks inherent in the Charity and taken steps to minimise such risk. Income is only recognised when it is received and accordingly further income may be due to the Charity and such income be accounted for in future years if and when it is received.

Structure and Governance

The Charity is governed by a governing document dated 5 February 2020. It is a Charitable Incorporated Organisation registered with the Charity Commission in England and Wales (no. 1188174).






