### Report of the trustees for the year ending 31<sup>st</sup> December 2024

The trustees present their annual report and financial statements of the charity for the year ending 31st December 2024. The financial statement is set out in appendix A of this document.

### Structure, governance, and management

Smile for Miley is a CIO registered under charity number 1188417, and is operated in compliance with its constitution dated 09/01/2020. The charity was established in 2020 in the memory of Miley Todd, who's short illness highlighted to her family how important it is that families have suitable support during the worst time in their life – when their son, daughter, brother or sister is critically ill or dying. We raise funds through donations and sponsorship, with money raised being granted to beneficiaries at regular intervals. 2024 was our fifth year in operation, and we managed to raise £22,580.10.



New trustees are appointed by existing trustees and serve for a period of 3 years, after which they may put themselves forward for re-appointment. The constitution provides for a minimum of 3 trustees and a maximum of 12. Since our last report, no changes have been made to our appointed trustees (see the *Trustees* section of this document).

The trustees must hold at least 1 general meeting of members each year. During this meeting, and any other meeting of members, trustees discuss any administrative activities which need to be addressed at the time, as well as any beneficiaries who the trustees are considering granting funds to. Minutes from the meeting are taken by the meeting facilitator and kept in the charity's records.

All trustees give their time freely, and no trustee remuneration was paid in the report period. No trustee expenses or related transactions were claimed during this period. Trustees are required to report any interest to all fellow trustees which they believe conflicts with their ability to act solely in the interest of the charity.

### **Risk management**

The trustees have considered the risks to which the charity is exposed. The charity does not make investments or own any assets, so risks are considered to be extremely low. The charity does not have many financial commitments (except for non-contractual monthly subscriptions for bookkeeping, website, etc.), so even if it is not possible to host events to bring in donations, the charity would not struggle to meet its obligations.

### **Objects and activities for the public benefit**

The objects of the charity are the relief of those in need by reason of ill-health (either directly or indirectly). In previous years, as we have been establishing ourselves, the trustees have primarily chosen to grant most of the funds raised directly to The Sick Children's Trust (Crawford House), whilst also looking to assist families directly in the local area. We operate within Cumbria and the Northeast of England. The trustees confirm that they have referred to the guidance contained in the Charity Commission's general guidance on public benefit when reviewing the charity's aims and objectives and in planning future events.

A total of 3 grants were made within the period of this report (2024), equalling £30,000.00.

A £10,000.00 grant was made to The Sick Children's Trust (Crawford House) in January 2024 – this was supposed to be made in 2023, but time constraints lead to it being delayed.

A £10,000.00 grant was made to Eden Valley Hospice in February 2024, and a further £10,000.00 grant was made to The Sick Children's Trust (Crawford House) in November 2024.



## **Grant making policy**

The charity has established its grant making policy to achieve its objects for the public benefit to assist and support the families of sick or deceased children in Cumbria and the Northeast of England. We review the grant making policy annually.

The beneficiaries of our grant making programme are ultimately the families of sick or deceased children. When a child is sick, dying, or has recently passed away, financial burdens can increase the stress or grief experienced by the family. Families may even have to adapt homes to accommodate for a sick child. The charity hopes to ease some of this burden for families in our area.

An online form is available through our website [smileformiley.com](https://smileformiley.com), which allows anybody to apply for a grant. Any requests are then reviewed by the trustees.

## **Financial review**

The charity's work is entirely reliant on the generosity of the people who participate in our events and those who sponsor them. At the start of this financial period (1st January 2024), we had an account balance of £44,517.83. Our year-end balance was £35,162.24. 3 grants were made during this period, as well as our usual administrative payments for accounting software, website hosting platform, etc.

## **Reserves policy**

The trustees consider that a reserve amount equal to 12 months of administrative costs should always be available in the account. This amount will be considered as £1,000.00 – though the actual amount would likely be less.

As detailed in the financial review above, the amount held in reserve at year end was £35,162.24. Having extra money held in reserve means that it is not being used to benefit our objects, and so should be kept to a minimum. The trustees are making arrangements to grant some of the excess funds as soon as possible.

## **Future plans**

Smile for Miley has a number of fundraising events planned for next year, with participants already coming forward. Details can be found on our website [smileformiley.com](https://smileformiley.com).

The trustees also plan to make a donation (grant) to The Sick Children's Trust (Crawford House) to the amount of £10,000.00. We also continue to look for families in the local area who are in need of extra support.



### **Trustee's responsibilities in relation to the financial statements**

The trustees are responsible for preparing the Trustees' Report and the financial statements in accordance with applicable law and United Kingdom Accounting Standards. ### **Financial review**

The charity's work is entirely reliant on the generosity of the people who participate in our events and those who sponsor them. At the start of this financial period (1st January 2023), we had an account balance of £30,156.89. Our year-end balance was £44,517.83. No grants were made during this period, and the only outgoings were administrative payments for accounting software, website hosting platform, etc.

### **Reserves policy**

The trustees consider that a reserve amount equal to 12 months of administrative costs should always be available in the account. This amount will be considered as £1,000.00 – though the actual amount would likely be less.

As detailed in the financial review above, the amount held in reserve at year end was £44,517.83. Having extra money held in reserve means that it is not being used to benefit our objects, and so should be kept to a minimum. The trustees are making arrangements to grant some of the excess funds as soon as possible.

### **Future plans**

Smile for Miley has a number of fundraising events planned for next year, with participants already coming forward. Details can be found on our website [smileformiley.com](http://smileformiley.com).

The trustees also plan to make a donation (grant) to The Sick Children's Trust (Crawford House) to the amount of £10,000.00. We also continue to look for families in the local area who are in need of extra support.

### Report of the trustees for the year ending 31<sup>st</sup> December 2022

The trustees present their annual report and financial statements of the charity for the year ending 31st December 2022. The financial statement is set out in appendix A of this document.

### Structure, governance, and management

Smile for Miley is a CIO registered under charity number 1188417, and is operated in compliance with its constitution dated 09/01/2020. The charity was established in 2020 in the memory of Miley Todd, who's short illness highlighted to her family how important it is that families have suitable support during the worst time in their life – when their son, daughter, brother or sister is critically ill or dying. We raise funds through donations and sponsorship, with money raised being granted to beneficiaries at regular intervals. 2022 was our third year in operation, and was our most successful one to date, as we managed to raise just short of £20,000 in donations (£19,873.40).

New trustees are appointed by existing trustees and serve for a period of 3 years, after which they may put themselves forward for re-appointment. The constitution provides for a minimum of 3 trustees and a maximum of 12. Since our last report, no changes have been made to our appointed trustees (see the *Trustees* section of this document).



The trustees must hold at least 1 general meeting of members each year. During this meeting, and any other meeting of members, trustees discuss any administrative activities which need to be addressed at the time, as well as any beneficiaries who the trustees are considering granting funds to. Minutes from the meeting are taken by the meeting facilitator and kept in the charity's records.

All trustees give their time freely, and no trustee remuneration was paid in the report period. No trustee expenses or related transactions were claimed during this period. Trustees are required to report any interest to all fellow trustees which they believe conflicts with their ability to act solely in the interest of the charity.

### **Risk management**

The trustees have considered the risks to which the charity is exposed. The charity does not make investments or own any assets, so risks are considered to be extremely low. The charity does not have many financial commitments (except for non-contractual monthly subscriptions for bookkeeping, website, etc.), so even if it is not possible to host events to bring in donations, the charity would not struggle to meet its obligations.

### **Objects and activities for the public benefit**

The objects of the charity are the relief of those in need by reason of ill-health (either directly or indirectly). In previous years, as we have been establishing ourselves, the trustees have primarily chosen to grant most of the funds raised directly to The Sick Children's Trust (Crawford House), whilst also looking to assist families directly in the local area. We operate within Cumbria and the Northeast of England. The trustees confirm that they have referred to the guidance contained in the Charity Commission's general guidance on public benefit when reviewing the charity's aims and objectives and in planning future events.

Only one grant was made within the period of this report (2022), which was a £10,000.00 grant to The Sick Children's Trust (Crawford House).

### **Grant making policy**

The charity has established its grant making policy to achieve its objects for the public benefit to assist and support the families of sick or deceased children in Cumbria and the Northeast of England. We review the grant making policy annually.

The beneficiaries of our grant making programme are ultimately the families of sick or deceased children. When a child is sick, dying, or has recently passed away, financial burdens can increase the stress or grief experienced by the family. Families may even have to adapt homes to accommodate for a sick child. The charity hopes to ease some of this burden for families in our area.



The trustees are due to review how people can apply for a grant, but this is likely to be an online form available through the charity's website.

### Report of the trustees for the year ending 31<sup>st</sup> December 2020

The trustees present their annual report and financial statements of the charity for the year ending 31<sup>st</sup> December 2021. The financial statement is set out in appendix A of this document.

### Structure, governance, and management

Smile for Miley is a CIO registered under charity number 1188417, and is operated in compliance with its constitution dated 09/01/2020. The charity was established in 2020 in the memory of Miley Todd, who's short illness highlighted to her family how important it is that families have suitable support during the worst time in their life – when their son, daughter, brother or sister is critically ill or dying. We raise funds through donations and sponsorship, with money raised being granted to beneficiaries at regular intervals. 2021 was only our second year in operation, but we still managed to raise over £10,000 in donations.

New trustees are appointed by existing trustees and serve for a period of 3 years, after which they may put themselves forward for re-appointment. The constitution provides for a minimum of 3 trustees and a maximum of 12. The first trustees were appointed with staggered terms, so that not



all trustees were due for re-appointment at the same time. The first 2 trustees who reached the end of their term did not put themselves forward for re-appointment.

The trustees must hold at least 1 general meeting of members each year. During this meeting, and any other meeting of members, trustees discuss any administrative activities which need to be addressed at the time, as well as any beneficiaries who the trustees are considering granting funds to. Minutes from the meeting are taken by the meeting facilitator and kept in the charity's records.

All trustees give their time freely, and no trustee remuneration was paid in the report period. No trustee expenses or related transactions were claimed during this period. Trustees are required to report any interest to all fellow trustees which they believe conflicts with their ability to act solely in the interest of the charity.

### **Risk Management**

The trustees have considered the risks to which the charity is exposed. The charity does not make investments or own any assets, so risks are considered to be extremely low. The charity does not have many financial commitments, so even if it is not possible to host events to bring in donations, the charity would not struggle to meet its obligations.

### **Objects and activities for the public benefit**

The objects of the charity are the relief of those in need by reason of ill-health (either directly or indirectly). At least for the first few years of operation, the trustees intend to grant most of the funds raised directly to The Sick Children's Trust (Crawford House), whilst also looking to assist families directly in the local area. We operate within Cumbria and the Northeast of England. The trustees confirm that they have referred to the guidance contained in the Charity Commission's general guidance on public benefit when reviewing the charity's aims and objectives and in planning future events.

Only one grant was made within the period of this report (2021), which was a £10,000.00 grant to The Sick Children's Trust (Crawford House).

### **Grant making policy**

The charity has established its grant making policy to achieve its objects for the public benefit to assist and support the families of sick or deceased children in Cumbria and the Northeast of England. We review the grant making policy annually.

The beneficiaries of our grant making programme are ultimately the families of sick or deceased children. When a child is sick, dying, or has recently passed away, financial burdens can increase the stress or grief experienced by the family. Families may even have to adapt homes to



accommodate for a sick child. The charity hopes to ease some of this burden for families in our area.

The trustees are due to review how people can apply for a grant, but this is likely to be an online form available through the charity's website.

### **Financial review**

The charity's work is entirely reliant on the generosity of the people who participate in our events and those who sponsor them. At the start of this financial period (1<sup>st</sup> January 2021), we had an account balance of £19,507.17. Our year end balance was £19,267.91. Only one grant of £10,000.00 was made – to The Sick Children's Trust (Crawford House) – during this period, with the only other outgoings being administrative payments for accounting software, website hosting platform, etc..

### **Reserves policy**

The trustees consider that a reserve amount equal to 12 months of administrative costs should always be available in the account. This amount will be considered as £1,000.00 – though the actual amount would likely be less.

As detailed in the financial review above, the amount held in reserve at year end was £19,267.91. Having extra money held in reserve means that it is not being used to benefit our objects, and so should be kept to a minimum. The trustees are making arrangements to grant some of the excess funds as soon as possible.

### **Plans for the future**
