Summary of the purposes of the charity as set out in its governing document	Para 1.17	<b>The purpose of Redeemer Grimsby is to exalt the name of Jesus Christ through gospel-centred worship, discipleship, community &amp; mission. We seek to advance the Christian faith through regular times of public worship ,prayer, Bible study, preaching &amp; teaching in Sunday services. Holy Communion is celebrated at least once a month. Our Pastor left at the end of October &amp; we are now an elder-led church. We have catered for &amp; endeavoured to include young people by them reading Bible passages during a service. We have sought to give &amp; encourage pastoral care &amp; have constantly reviewed our programme as our duty to 'love one another'. We have supported &amp; encouraged charitable social action in the local community as several of our members volunteer in the local food banks &amp; food kitchens. In order to be more charitable we are setting up monthly donations to the following four charities :- The Bible Society, Compassion ( we support a young child in Ghana), Open Door ( to support the persecuted Church), Hope for Justice (anti-slavery &amp; human trafficking).</b>

Para 1.17 and 1.19	Due to the pandemic & resultant lockdowns our meetings were limited but we have conducted 31 Sunday services & a corresponding number of meetings on Monday evenings which alternate between prayer meetings & Bible studies. During the lockdowns we have been able to make use of Zoom, You Tube & Facebook to maintain contact & to continue with live streamed acts of public worship, prayer & Bible study. Our meetings take place in the Scout Hut at 188 Cooper Road, Grimsby but we are currently in discussions with another local church to amalgamate so that we may have more permanent premises. Since our Pastor left the sermons have been shared between 6 members of the church. Attendance has generally been between 10 & 20 people. when he left we had 7 members but we now have 15. Taking the period as a whole, although we are small in number but because we all share in the duties & responsibilities of running the church we have all grown much closer as a family of God & that there has been a renewed vitality & spirit in the church.
