Activities: Nalam Vaala provides a much-needed intervention to help young people and adults gain motivation, self-confidence and key academic and employability skills. Our focus was families who were displaced during the final phase of the brutal civil war in Sri Lanka and our work so far helped young people who are not motivated in learning skills because of their experiences during the civil war.





We are in discussion with that school with regard to supporting the children.</p> <p>We organised a charity walk in London in September 2022 and raised about £715 through crowd funding.</p> <p>During this reporting period, we are pursuing to register our organisation as a Trust in Sri Lanka.</p> <p>We are also planning to launch a pilot project (English literacy after-school non-formal-learning project) soon.</p>
