Most of the year was spent completing essential tasks and filling in forms to make sure that the charity was established, with a recognisable identity and solid presence. We sorted an address, a website and mailing list, bank account, Gift Aid and gentle marketing, which included contact cards, posters and pin badges. We also sorted a promotional video, telling the story of the first project the charity aims to complete. The charity obtained a space on four social media sites and has begun posting and developing a following. There was very little fundraising done, by being in public places and asking people to donate. More time was spent speaking to people who know about and have experience with charity work, learning what we could and getting as much help, for the short and long term, as possible. By doing so, the charity has increased its network and will look to capitalise on this moving forward.
