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Report of Trustees

The Trustees present their report and financial statements for the year ended 30 April 2021.

Charity: Pregnant in West London: 1189389

General Description of the Charity's activities

The main aim of Pregnant in West London is the advancement of education in the subjects of pregnancy, labour and delivery, breastfeeding and neonatal care.

The preservation and protection of good physical and mental health and wellbeing among women during pregnancy and during the post natal period by providing information and advice designed to ensure that they are confident and supported to make well informed choices which will result in positive health outcomes for themselves and their babies.

Pregnant in West London provides free antenatal and postnatal birthing classes covering subjects including labour, birth nutrition, mental health, first aid, pain relief and coming home with baby. Applicants join one round at a time which consist of eight weekly sessions that cover all the topics mentioned above. All our speakers are registered professionals in their own field. We aim to continue these much-needed classes in West London, as we have an ever-growing demand, from constant referrals by the NHS midwives, NHS GP'S and social workers, who all highly recommend us. We currently run all our sessions on Zoom but aim to also deliver face to face when appropriate.

Our sessions are all funded by the grants and donations that the trustees work hard to achieve throughout the year.

Risk Management

The Trustees actively review the risk, which the Charity faces on a regular basis. The review of the controls of the financial systems will provide sufficient resources in the event of adverse conditions.

The Trustees have also examined other operational and business risks faced by the Charity and confirm that the Trustees have established systems to mitigate the significant risks.
