Annual Trustees Report

July 2024 – June 2025

The Barley Greyhound Sanctuary Trustees present their fifth annual report.

We currently have 12 Greyhounds looking for their forever homes and 8 sponsor Greyhounds who live with us permanently at the sanctuary due to medical / temperament problems that mean they can't be homed but can live long and happy lives in the safety of Barley.

Between July 2024 and June 2025, we took 25 Greyhounds into our care and found loving homes for 20 during the same period. Both figures are sadly down significantly again compared to pre-covid numbers. The continued cost-of-living crisis understandably seems to be having a massive effect on adoptions. We also tend to specialise in Greyhounds who have more complex behavioural needs, and in turn this means that fewer homes are suitable to adopt from us. Responsible rehoming will always be our top priority. We are as always still incredibly proud that we've been able to help the number of dogs that we have this year and hope that adoption enquiries will rise again in the coming years. Since Barley Greyhound Sanctuary became an independent Charity, we have found 179 Greyhounds forever homes. This year we also helped several stray lurchers who needed rescue and rehabilitation.

We said a sad farewell to our Trustee Hayley Wademan who decided to step back due to personal reasons. She has 1 'Barley' Greyhound at home and will continue to support our work. We welcomed Neil Hancock as a new Trustee; he has been a volunteer with us for many years and currently has a 'Barley' Greyhound at home. We are sure he will be a huge asset to our team.

Our total outgoings for this period were £76,332; this is up on last year due to rising costs. Our total income being £52,964 which is significantly down on last year. Going forward we will still rely heavily on donations to be able to continue the work that we do to help Greyhounds retiring from the racing industry, strays and those that find themselves in need of rescue.

We continue to suggest a guideline donation of £200 from adopters and this helps towards the cost of the items and homing pack that each of our dogs go home with. We are fortunate that many adopters give generously with their adoption donations. We are registered with Easy Fundraising and Give as you live.

We attended the East Anglian Game & Country Fair and other events to raise awareness to Greyhounds. This year we hope to get out to more events to help more Greyhounds find their forever homes, raise awareness to Greyhounds and what fantastic pets they make and to help increase our income. We hope to hold an open weekend over the Easter period.

Going forward we will be helping more dogs that can't be homed due to temperament issues to ensure they get to live out long and happy lives.



We currently have 20 Greyhounds looking for their forever homes and 7 sponsor Greyhounds who live with us permanently at the sanctuary due to medical / temperament problems that mean they can't be homed but can live long and happy lives in the safety of Barley. We very sadly lost sponsor dog, Ted, to illness. He is remembered with a rose and memory stone in our memorial garden.

Between July 2023 and June 2024, we took 31 Greyhounds into our care and found loving homes for 28 during the same period. Both figures are sadly down significantly compared to pre-covid numbers. The continued cost-of-living crisis understandably seems to be having a massive effect on adoptions. We are as always still incredibly proud that we've been able to help the number of dogs that we have this year and hope that adoption enquiries will rise again in the coming years. Since Barley Greyhound Sanctuary became an independent Charity, we have found 159 Greyhounds forever homes.

We said a sad farewell to our Trustee Anne Gransby who has moved away from our area. She has 1 'Barley' Greyhound at home and will continue to support our work and help at events. We welcomed David Creasey as a new Trustee, he has been a volunteer with us for many years and currently has 2 'Barley' Greyhounds at home. We are sure he will be a huge asset to our team.

Our total outgoings for this period were £66,543, this is down slightly on last year with our total income being £93,800 which is up on last year due to a generous legacy. Going forward we will still rely heavily on donations to be able to continue the work that we do to help Greyhounds retiring from the racing industry, strays and those that find themselves in need of rescue.

We continue to suggest a guideline donation of £200 from adopters and this helps towards the cost of the items and homing pack that each of our dogs go home with. We are fortunate that many adopters give generously with their adoption donations. We are registered with Easy Fundraising and Give as you live.

In January we were lucky to become charity partners with the Pets Foundation again, so we have been in our local Pets at Home store raising awareness throughout the year. 



Annual Trustees Report

July 2021 – June 2022

The Barley Greyhound Sanctuary Trustees present their second annual report.

We currently have 20 Greyhounds and 2 Lurchers available for adoption. We also have our 9 sponsor Greyhounds who live with us permanently at the sanctuary due to medical / temperament problems that mean they can't be homed but can live long and happy lives in the safety of Barley. Sponsor dogs Paddy, Tilly & Rocky sadly passed away in 2021/22 and they are remembered with a Rose and memory stone in our memorial garden at the sanctuary.

Between July 2021 and June 2022 we took 33 Greyhounds into our care and found loving homes for 36 during the same period. This number is sadly down again compared to previous years. The cost-of-living crisis understandably seems to be having a massive effect on adoptions. We are however still extremely proud to have helped the number of dogs that we have and hope that these numbers will begin to pick up again soon.

Since Barley Greyhound Sanctuary became an independent charity we have successfully found 90 Greyhounds forever homes.

We said a sad farewell to our Trustee Glen Davis who has moved away from our area and felt he couldn't commit as much as he would like to. He will continue to support our work and has 2 retired Greyhounds of his own at home. We welcomed Hayley Wademan as a new Trustee who has a passion for Greyhounds and is a huge help to us at Barley.

Our total outgoings for this time period were £63,105, this is down by £5,222 on last year with our total income being £63,325 which is up by £205.00 on last year. Going forward we will still rely heavily on donations to be able to continue the work that we do and are extremely grateful for all the help and support we receive. We hope to get out to more events this year to raise awareness to Greyhounds as pets and the work that we do to help Greyhounds who retire from the racing industry.

We continue to suggest a guideline donation of £200 from adopters and this helps towards the cost of the items and homing pack that each of our dogs go home with. We are fortunate that many adopters give generously with their adoption donations. We are registered with Easy Fundraising, Amazon Smile and Give as you live.

We were grateful to receive donations totalling £6325.00 from the Pets at Home Foundation. We also appreciate everyone who has supported us this year with donations and helping in other ways.

This year we hope to get out to more events to help more Greyhounds find their forever homes, raise awareness to Greyhounds and what fantastic pets they make and also help increase our income.

Annual Trustees Report

July 2020 – June 2021

The Barley Greyhound Sanctuary trustees present their first annual report.

In our first year after severing ties with The Greyhound Trust we are pleased to have homed 54 dogs from June 2020 to July 2021. This figure is sadly lower than previous years due to the restrictions put in place during the Covid lockdown. As covid restrictions ease we hope to increase our homing figures again.

We currently have 20 Greyhounds available for adoption and 11 sponsored Greyhounds that live with us permanently at the kennels due to medical / temperament problems meaning they can't be homed but can lead long and happy lives in the safety of Barley.

The Greyhound Retirement Scheme (GRS) initiated by the Greyhound Board of Great Britain (GBGB) in September 2020 has so far contributed £16,400 towards the care of some of the dogs coming into our kennels from registered trainers. This scheme has been put in place to try and help secure a safe retirement for GBGB registered Greyhounds but there are still Greyhounds not attached to the bond, strays and occasionally lurchers that enter our care with no financial support.

Our total outgoings for the year ending July 2021 were £68,372 and our total income was £62,989 so we still rely heavily on donations that we are always very grateful to receive and allow us to continue to help Greyhounds retiring from racing. As covid restrictions begin to ease we hope to start doing more fundraising events again which will help greatly with funding and also raise awareness to Greyhounds making amazing pets.

We suggest a guideline donation of £200 from adopters of Greyhounds and this helps towards the costs of the items and homing pack that each of our dogs go home with and we are fortunate that most adopters give generously with their rehoming donations. Fundraising events that we have been allowed to hold this year have been supported well. We are registered with Easyfundraising and Amazon Smile.

We are very fortunate to be the charity partner of the Pets at Home foundation at our local store in Waltham Abbey. We have previously received grants in order to purchase a large food storage container and assistance with vet bills. We are greatly indebted to them for their continuing support.

We were nominated for the Petplan charity draw and awarded a cheque for £1000 that was much appreciated and helped greatly towards vets bills.

We are also extremely grateful to all our supporters and followers who make donations to help us continue the work that we do for Greyhounds.

Going forward we are aware that we need to increase our income and reduce our outgoings. We are constantly looking at ways of doing this as we are determined to continue caring for, and finding suitable homes for these wonderful dogs. We are

hoping that Covid restrictions will continue to ease to allow us to carry out more fundraising and Greyhounds as pets awareness events.
