FOUNTAIN LIFE FOUNDATION ANNUAL REPORT

Reporting Period: 1 July 2024 – 30 June 2025

This report outlines the activities, impact, and progress of Fountain **Life** Foundation over the stated period. Detailed monthly accounts are provided below.

JULY 2024

July 2024 marked a monumental period for Fountain Life Foundation, characterized by significant ministry outreach and spiritual impact across the United States. During this month, the founder of Fountain Life Foundation, Elishua Dewey, ministered extensively in South Carolina, engaging with individuals from challenging backgrounds, including ex-gang members, former prisoners, and those recovering from drug addiction. These gatherings were marked by powerful moments of transformation, restoration, and renewed hope as the message of the Gospel was shared. A key highlight was ministry at New Life Deliverance Church, where lives were deeply impacted through preaching, prayer, and personal ministry. During these meetings, numerous healings were recorded, with individuals testifying to the restoration of their bodies—particularly in shoulders and arms. These testimonies were captured on video and are available on the Elishua Dewey YouTube channel, serving as documented evidence of the impact of these ministry gatherings. The outreach extended further through travel to West Chesapeake, where Elishua Dewey ministered in a Methodist church and visited several other denominational churches throughout the region. The month concluded with a strategic transition to Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, where Elishua Dewey, founder of Fountain Life Ministries, attended a conference at Revival Today Church, focused on impartation, revelation, spiritual refreshing, and further training. This time of equipping served to strengthen the foundation for ongoing ministry work, ensuring continued effectiveness and growth in both outreach and discipleship efforts.



AUGUST 2024

In August 2024, Evangelist Elishua returned to the United Kingdom, dedicating much of the month to reconnecting with board members, strengthening organizational alignment, and advancing key administrative matters. This period also included active ministry engagements across various locations.

A notable highlight was participation in outreach efforts in King's Cross alongside Nation's Call London Church, where the Gospel was shared in a public setting. Key highlights included testimonies of severely sick individuals coming to receive the love of God and finding relief through prayer. Others were reached as the wider community was uplifted and serenaded with gospel songs, creating an atmosphere of hope and encouragement.

The month also provided an important window for renewing essential documentation, alongside intentional time for spiritual refreshing and physical rest. This preparation was strategic, positioning the ministry for the upcoming return to Kenya. Looking ahead, the focus was set on the God is Love campaigns scheduled for September, with a clear objective to reach 10,000 youth with the message of God's love.

SEPTEMBER 2024

In September 2024, the ministry returned to Kenya with renewed focus and momentum to carry out the God is Love school campaigns. This marked a significant outreach phase, targeting young people with the message of God's love across multiple school settings. These campaigns were met with strong engagement, as students were reached with the Gospel in a clear and impactful way. The initiative formed part of the broader objective to reach thousands of youth, bringing encouragement, truth, and spiritual awakening within the school environments. OCTOBER 2024

In October 2024, the ministry partnered with an established church in the Eastland's area of Buru Buru, Makadara, to conduct a large-scale gospel campaign. The focus of this outreach was to share the good news of the Gospel, pray for the sick, and challenge individuals with a message of hope, light, love, and eternal destiny.

This campaign was marked by numerous powerful testimonies. Notably, numerous individuals with varying degrees of blindness—from impaired vision and short-sightedness to complete blindness—testified of receiving full restoration of sight. One testimony included a man who had previously been robbed and struck in the head with a piece of wood, resulting in blindness in his right eye; he testified that his sight was restored. Another individual, who had suffered a severe leg injury from an accident and was unable to walk properly due to a twisted leg, experienced a visible straightening and began walking normally before the crowd.

Additionally, deaf ears were opened, and many individuals experiencing spiritual oppression testified to receiving freedom and liberty. The preaching of the Gospel brought a tangible shift in the atmosphere, as the message of Jesus Christ brought life, peace, and transformation to those in attendance.

Throughout the month, Evangelist Elishua also served local churches and communities, continuing to fulfill the mission of spreading the good news of the Gospel across selected regions within the nation of Kenya. All of these activities have been documented through media and video recordings, available for viewing on the ministry's YouTube channel.

NOVEMBER 2024

In November 2024, the ministry made strategic investments into its media arm, developing and advancing its podcast platform, which is available on the ministry's YouTube channel. This initiative was aimed at expanding digital reach and creating ongoing access to teaching, testimonies, and Gospel-centered content. Alongside this, the ministry continued active street outreaches, engaging directly with individuals in public spaces and sharing the message of the Gospel. During this month, the ministry also strengthened its operational capacity through the purchase of a new generator, supporting the logistical needs of ongoing and future outreach efforts.



Evangelist Elishua also traveled to western Kenya, ministering in Rongo, Busia, and Kisumu. During this time, he shared the Gospel and his personal testimony of deliverance and freedom from addiction through radio broadcasts, extending the reach of the message to a wider regional audience. Throughout this period, he ministered to thousands across various locations, including conferences and gatherings with different local church bodies, making a significant, far-reaching impact. DECEMBER 2024

In December 2024, Evangelist Elishua traveled to Uganda, where he ministered across various locations and churches, continuing the work of sharing the Gospel and strengthening believers.

During this period, he also spent the Christmas season in fellowship with friends of the ministry and a host family, taking time to build relationships and reflect on the impact of the year.

This month marked a transition point, as preparations were made for the next phase of the mission, with travel arrangements set in place to depart in January for continued ministry work in Nigeria.

JANUARY 2025

In January 2025, the ministry entered a new phase of international outreach. A ministry vehicle was stationed securely in Uganda as Evangelist Elishua departed by air to Port Harcourt, Nigeria, to join a ministry team for further training and active engagements.

During this time, he joined friends of the ministry and a wider team to partake in further training through a large-scale conference in Port Harcourt, which hosted thousands of attendees. This season provided the opportunity to preach on Salvation Television Station, which has a global reach, broadcasting to many nations and an audience exceeding 100 million viewers. It was a significant time of equipping, learning, and spiritual growth, alongside actively exercising faith in ministry. Following this, he engaged in



marketplace ministry, taking the message of Jesus directly into everyday environments.

The outreach then continued with travel to Lagos, where further ministry took place through conference settings as well as continued marketplace evangelism. Additional movements included Lekki and Abuja, expanding the reach of the Gospel across multiple regions within Nigeria.

This marked the beginning of 2025 with a strategic three-nation tour over a three-month period, reflecting the growing scope and momentum of Fountain Life Foundation's mission. For those interested, highlights from this period can also be viewed on the ministry's 2025 highlight video.

FEBRUARY / MARCH 2025

February 2025 was a significant and personal month, as Evangelist Elishua returned to Australia for the first time in 11 years. This visit provided an important opportunity to reconnect with family and friends, while also opening doors for ministry and future mission engagements.

During this time, several ministry opportunities emerged, including a tent mission in the Riverland region and an open door to minister to a few hundred people in a coastal area. In addition, Evangelist Elishua returned to his roots, visiting and ministering within the local church where he was founded, established, and mentored. He preached across three different locations, strengthening believers and reconnecting with the foundational community that played a key role in his early development.

This period also served as a time of preparation and planning for the next phase of the mission. Arrangements were made for a return to Uganda, where the ministry secured significant support from newfound friends and partners in Australia to conduct Divine Nature Miracle Conferences across three locations—one large-scale gathering in western Uganda and two medium-sized conferences in Kampala. The western Uganda conference reached the airwaves and gathered hundreds in attendance, including over 50 local church leaders who received training and equipping, aligning with a foundational purpose of Fountain Life Foundation.



APRIL 2025

In April 2025, the ministry concluded the third nation of its multi-country mission, returning to Uganda to carry out a strategically planned phase of outreach. Significant preparation had already been undertaken while in Australia, working closely with coordinators to organize a major conference in the western region of Uganda.

This resulted in the Fire and Nature Miracle Conference, a large-scale gathering that incorporated radio broadcasting and drew strong attendance. The conference also hosted a number of church leaders who participated over a four-day period, receiving teaching, impartation, and equipping. In addition to the conference, Evangelist Elishua ministered at Agape Church and also attended sessions at Miracle Centre Cathedral, where he received impartation under the ministry of Dr. Robert Kayanja. This period marked a powerful culmination of preparation, collaboration, and impactful ministry engagement, while fulfilling the focus, purpose, and vision of Fountain Life Foundation, also known as Fountain Life Ministry (www.fountainlifeministry.org).

MAY 2025

In May 2025, Evangelist Elishua departed from Uganda, crossing over the border into western Kenya and continuing the ministry journey. This phase included fulfilling planned engagements with Word of Praise Church in Mbale and Fellowship Church in Kakamega. During this time, he ministered within these church communities and also met with numerous pastors, engaging in strategic discussions regarding future collaborations and upcoming campaigns to spread the message of God's love throughout the western region of Kenya.

JUNE 2025

June 2025 marked a significant milestone for Fountain Life Foundation, celebrating five years of ministry, outreach, and impact. This anniversary reflected the faithfulness of the journey, the growth of the work, and the lives transformed through the message of Jesus Christ.



During this month, Evangelist Elishua continued ministering across established churches in Kenya, including Redeemed Gospel Church in Buruburu, Eastlands, strengthening believers and advancing the Gospel. This period also included forward planning for the upcoming months of July and August 2025, setting the stage for continued expansion and increased outreach efforts, which will be detailed in the next annual report. Fountain Life Foundation is supported by a committed group of partners who give faithfully at different times throughout the year. As the ministry continues to grow, there is an open invitation for new partners to collaborate in expanding the reach and impact of future campaigns and conferences. Introduction:

In this report I will give an account and over view of our activities regarding the period 1-07-2023 to 30-06-2024. This effectively was the fourth year of being a registered charity. Why there has defiantly been growth and development – we have vision and passion to develop more and grow. JULY: Starting from the 1-07-2023 Fountain Life Ministry applied for the Ministerial fellowship of RMIMA. RMIMA is a body of over 300 independent like-minded organizations that come under the banner of Revival ministries international which has a base in Tampa bay Florida. During this time in Florida Fountain Life attended a day conference as well as partnered with **Don Walker Ministries**. To hold a community outreach event in St Petersburg, Florida which aimed to reach drug addicts, the homeless and gang members in the area. Hiring the local community facility, we conducted a 3-day event. During the outreach boxes of food and bibles were given away to people in need. Elishua Dewey from Fountain Life Ministry was the main speaker at these events and communicated The gospel of Jesus Christ to the people that gathered in the evening events. It is my privilege to report over 100 people were recorded making decisions to receive Jesus Christ as their Lord and savior. During this time, we also held baptism classes and did water baptisms for those who wanted to be water baptized.

Upon returning back to Kenya in July, we continued to build team, support the local churches and conduct street outreaches in the marketplace, where we fed people, we prayed for people with

sicknesses and taught the principles of the Bible, in the open place, and many, many found freedom found liberty, and found the love of God. It was beautiful. During this month, we were ministering in the deliverance church with a two-day conference on evangelism, equipping and training people in effectively sharing the faith of the gospel and the love of God to their local community.

AUGUST: In August, we continued pioneering services in the local marketplace, ministering at churches where many came to Christ. Services included discipleship, market place ministry, ministering to the sick and meeting various needs as we came across them.

SEPTEMBER & OCTOBER

In September, Elishua took a mission trip, to South Africa, where he visited several churches from Cape Town, Johannesburg and Durban including the Full Gospel Church, AGM and several others. In Durban, I spoke to the youth, I spoke on radio, I spoke at multiple churches with the AGM, and it was wonderful time. I also visited the drug and alcohol rehabilitation center at the rest Haven, and ministered to the young men that were there battling addictions ranging from Narcotics to Alcohol and more, seeing several get deliverance and give their lives to Christ. Upon hearing my testimony, it was evident all received hope in their own life to see the change that they desire. In Cape I took the Full gospel church for a 3-day evangelism seminar and held classic meetings in the church during the evening. Also in Cape town, during our time together with Sword ministries we combined a street outreach to feed over 100 people in a gang torn region called Khayelitsha, Cape town.

NOVEMBER: In the month of November, I returned to Kenya where we held a large gospel camping with the redeemed gospel church Athi-River in a place called Sabaki. It was a great success and the largest one we did up to that date with a good number over one thousand in attendance. I also joined a team with the Deliverance Church and traveled to a place called Samburu in the Northern part of Kenya, where we reached out to the indigenous people of the land. Ministering at a conference with the Kenya Assemblies of God. Market place outreach Delivering the afflicted from spiritual oppression.

DECEMBER:

In the month of December, I traveled to Western Kenya to a place called Kisumu, where we held a four-day open gospel campaign with in the local church setting. I also ministered a teaching in a conference, 1000s were in attendance at this gospel camping mainly put on by the church, multiple people testifying of healings, testimonies of deaf ears, blind eyes and demon possessed people getting freedom, getting healing, and Jesus Christ getting glorified. January:

In January, still in Kenya, Began our God is love youth rallies with the Aflame Ministry in Surrounding schools of Nairobi and Ngong, Kassarani. I traveled to numerous schools sharing on the biblical theme of being created in the image of God and being made according to his likeness who the bible says is love. We spoke about the possibilities of a person's life who follows the Bible and follows the wisdom and the teaching of Jesus Christ can go. I also performed my gospel rap in many of the schools and the youth had a blast. We were covered by Aflame Ministries who work in the schools. I shared testimonies that broke into the hearts of the youth what God has done in my life in the midst of seemingly impossible situations and challenges, and encouraged them in the faith and to develop a trust and reliance in God during the good times and the hard times.

FEBUARY:

In the month of February, we continued with the divine nature live stream. We booked a place on a TV station called EBN that broadcast into the rural parts of Kenya and started a series called The Divine explosion, also traveling to speak to 1000s of boys in all boy's school in a place called RONGI, and sharing my testimony, talking about being made in the image of God and following the teachings and the God of the Bible to live a healthy and prosperous existence. many 1000s were impacted. We saw hundreds give their commit their lives to follow Jesus, as we worked with the aflame ministries, who were local and in conjunction with the education system, and the schools in Kenya.

MARCH & April

In March continued with the tv series of the final explosion, engaged in some several mainstream, established churches, and also carried on going out to the Marketplace. Continued With the TV series and prepared for a journey to America. In March also ministered at a conference for glory realm church in Nairobi another branch of the Deliverance Church and a 5 day meeting in Redeemed Gospel Church Buru Buru. We have been moving between denominational barriers with teaching and preaching focused mainly on Jesus Christ.

MAY & JUNE

In May, landed in Missouri among a handful of churches before flying to Tampa bay Florida for a conference and ceremony to receive a license into the RMIMA fellowship body previously applied for last July. Later flying to South Carolina to be in South Carolina the 31st May until the 2nd of June, where we did a three-day conference, also ministering for the Redemptive Calvary church for a 4 day meeting. Before leaving and coming back to Kenya for the remaining of June where we continued to travel in the schools reaching the youth with the love of God and the message of the gospel.

I particularly want to thank faithful friends who have been partners and donors and allowed us to do what we've done. I am grateful that you trust and believe in Fountain Life Ministry and me (Elishua Dewey) Its founder. It is an honor to serve. I believe we've made a positive difference in the world together, and we're believing for greater things to come through the work of Fountain Life Foundation, charity and fountain life ministry, as we continue to serve the purpose of the charity.

INTRO: This report will capture in a paragraph or less month to month activity during the above period. In line with Charitable goals, objectives and purposes. - 1. APRIL 2022:** I Came of the Mission Field of East Africa for a short break in the U.K. During this time we had several meetings in United Kingdom which involved training and equipping a church in the work of the gospel in the local area namely Kings Cross. Also traveling to Norwich to train and equip a small church there and then embarking on outdoor gospel work in the local community. Finally helping a small local church in Guildford doing the same training and equipping program. After taking a small rest and spending time with our local church covering Fountain Life Ministry went back into Kenya to engage further in the purpose and vision of the charity. Upon returning we took an office at Nalepo Business centre hired a hall and began training and equipping Pastors and leaders, and began discipling those who had made decisions to be Christians through our prior gospel campaigns. After dedicating Wednesday to meet people at the local bus station prior to leaving for the U.K upon returning we took the office and hired a hall and conducted regular meetings every Friday evening.
- 2. May 2022:** The Mission work aimed at outreaching to the local community young men particularly who seemed to just gather all day at the bus station. A group of homeless men also were not far from the outreach which we ministered to and at times fed them spontaneously at the end of our outdoor meetings. We also traveled to Busia and held a conference in this region for Pastors and leaders and aided the local churches there. Before coming back and holding a larger campaign in a place called Mlolongo – partnering with the Redeemed Gospel Church of Kenya to see many impacted. Testimonies of physical healings and many making decisions to embrace Jesus Christ and getting spiritual help that led to their freedom. We began teaching of the gospel to empower and enrich their lives. Those reading this report and are interested further please go to our YouTube channel for footage captured during this mission work.
- 3. June 2022:** In June we held a major gospel campaign in a place called Slum and Lukathi. This place was out on the lands and held a population of 700 ppl We managed to raise enough money to cater for 120 charity boxes which consisted of
 - **Soap**
 - **Tea**
 - **Toothbrush**

- **Toothpaste**
- **2kg flour.**
- **Half litre of cooking oil**
- **1 KG sugar**
- **Bag of salt**
- **5 litre bottle of water**

and distributed them the day before our 3-day gospel outreach. The land had (Please see footage on our YouTube channel) During the campaign many soul were added to the local church community and many testified of remarkable healing that took place in the name of Jesus.

4. **July:** July we traveled to Mombasa for a conference. During this time, we reached out to many in the area that were on drugs and alcohol and the homeless while partnering with the local church equipping them and empowering them on how to be effective in helping issues that surrounded their city. When arriving back to Kitngela we partnered with Redeemed gospel church for another outreach in Mlolongo where many people received Christ and became a part of the local church in Athi-River. We continued to hold training and equipping at the mission center while also traveling around to different areas engaging in invitations from local churches.
5. **August:** I traveled with some men form the mission center to a place called Mowlem, 6 miles outside Nairobi and ministered to the church and a small treat outreach. We kept on doing the outreach in the local fruit market around the main bus station Kitneglea sometimes 5 meetings a week.
6. **September:** September Fountain Life Foundation join walking like Jesus ministry as part of the team to do mission work in Ethiopia. APRIL 2022:** I Came of the Mission Field of East Africa for a short break in the U.K. During this time we had several meetings in United Kingdom which involved training and equipping a church in the work of the gospel in the local area namely Kings Cross. Also traveling to Norwich to train and equip a small church there and then embarking on outdoor gospel work in the local community. Finally helping a small local church in Guildford doing the same training and equipping program. After taking a small rest and spending time with our local church covering Fountain Life Ministry went back into Kenya to engage further in the purpose and vision of the charity. Upon returning we took an office at Nalepo Business centre hired a hall and began training and equipping Pastors and leaders, and began discipling those who had made decisions to be Christians through our prior gospel campaigns. After dedicating Wednesday to meet people at the local bus station prior to leaving for the U.K upon returning we took the office and hired a hall and conducted regular meetings every Friday evening.

A group of homeless men also were not far from the outreach which we ministered to and at times fed them spontaneously at the end of our outdoor meetings. We also traveled to Busia and held a conference in this region for Pastors and leaders and aided the local churches there. This is the beginning of our report for the period of 2021-22. I am pleased to report we have had movement with our purpose and mission statement during these periods. While finishing our media campaigns with Faith World T.V and doing some feeding programs and small outreaches on the U.K soil - Predominantly, the charity has had a focus on reaching into some of the African nations. From September 2021 this became a reality as our director Brett Dewey made some bold steps to carry on the momentum and step out into Kenya. Initially, we had some connections and friends that we went to meet as we entered the nation. Our first move was made when we booked a venue and held a conference in Westland's Nairobi, Kenya of which 40 ppl were in attendance. The main topic was creation being made by a creator and the bibles teaching on the image of the creator whose image man is made in. It was a remarkable time and some notable changes took place in the lives of those who attended. During this time the charity catered for a two-course lunch. This was the beginning of a series of places Fountain Life visited holding meetings and teaching the bible and seeing some impact on a physical and spiritual scale. From Westland's to Machakos and also held meetings in Kibera where the largest Slum in Nairobi is and the largest urban slum in Africa

Among many places along the way that were visited and churches, we connected with along the way. We ended up in far western Kenya in a place called Bungoma which is right on the border of Uganda and Kenya where we held a 21-day series of events that included training outreach and feeding programs. During this time I had fallen sick with Malaria twice and a very bad stomach bacteria which affected me for over weeks causing me to lose 20kg. As I was planning to cross over to Uganda and carry on the mission. Due to a phone call and a redirection the expedition turned back towards Nairobi as I was taken to Eldoret and met a friend of a friend who took me back to Kitengela which is 40 km North West of Nairobi. Here I met a man who was a leader of an organization and he had a large mission house he let me stay at. During this time I received some medical treatment and recovered a little before 2 weeks we both joined together to carry on the mission - as we traveled to Busia, Kisumu, and another place out where they had wild elephants (I can't pronoun its name) This man had been planting churches in these areas and Fountain Life came alongside that work. In December 2021 I left my friend in Busia and traveled over to Uganda where I was met by a connection who took me to Jinja where I spoke to several large groups of believers and shared some training and equipping with them before boarding a plane and crossing over to South Sudan, Juba to connect with a much

larger organization who was having a massive gospel event there. I was there approx. 8 days in which time I spoke at a few places which included a local radio station and got to share about the God who is love that saved me, imparting hope and comfort into many (over 500k) people who were listening.

During this time in Juba, we connect with an organization that helps the street boys in South Sudan - who lost their parent during the civil unrest over a decade ago. We gave some little we had as I shared with some the love of God.

When coming back to Kenya we engaged in one other trip which saw us travel several hours to a location on the foot of a hill where we spent the week I spoke at a conference there before returning and planning spontaneously for a new year's Eve Tent mission that reaches hundreds of people and seen many receive the divine healing the bible teaches is available.

During this event Fountain Life made a good connection with the Redeemed Gospel Church Kenya - and soon after they let us use some of their equipment for the running cost price

To hold some larger gospel campaigns in rural areas, thus carrying out the purpose of the charity in an excellent fashion. After our tent mission, many people had responded to want to be taught from the bible So we started meeting at the Bus station once a week under a bus shelter to train and teach from the Bible. Many started coming which included those who were homeless, suffering from poverty, and addicted to drugs and alcohol. Around April 2022 - I made a trip back to the U.K to hold some meetings with other organizations and took 4 weeks out of Africa before returning - opening a small office hiring a hall and conducting training and holding meetings regularly. The board has discussed the future plans and purpose of Fountain Life Foundation. In conjunction with our purpose and goal - we are in the process of opening up a Mission Centre in Kenya as a base. The Divine Nature Mission Centre will be located in Kitengela, Kenya, and carry out the priority of the Mission Statement and purposes of the Charity. We have continued to find favor with friends and partners with a small select group of friends who have helped our Charity grow along the way. 1) Brief back ground and history into Fountain life Ministry

It has been a good journey, not always has it been easy but the effort has been worth it all. In order to highlight where we are now and where we are going, I would like to give a brief on how we got to where we are today and take this opportunity to paint an overall picture for those reading this report. Prior to becoming a charity – fountain life vision was carried by its founder Brett Dewey. The work into Africa began in 2009 with youth conferences in Uganda, outreaches to widows villages and visits to Orphans providing some support in feeding programs to Orphans. Buying livestock of goats for breeding programs as well as bringing the message of hope and love from the life of Jesus in the Holy Bible via Media broadcast. Financially this mission was largely carried at a personal cost with the exception of a few friends and family that also helped fund it. In 2010 Brett travelled to England U.K from Australia to commence a 2-year bible college to better understand the teaching of the bible with the vision to carry on the work in his heart in the east/central Africa communities. During this time Brett served the Elim organization conducting many outreaches on their behalf into London, U.K and some parts of Europe. After graduation – the Bible College this continued for a few years. 2018 charity work continued with two trips to Africa being Uganda and Kenya. 2020 was the year Brett wrote and launched a book; Every Day In The Life of Jesus – Following The Son of God Follow. Going onto Christian Television. Fountain Life Foundation officially launching the Charity with help from a friend on -04-06-2020 – Fountain Life Foundation became official.

2) Transition into fountain life foundation CIO charity status

Financially, prior to becoming a registered Charity the work has been funded via a few friends and the founder of the Charity.

The Charity formed as a result of an overflow from the passion and love for the vision of its founder.

- Nothing much changed during the first year as a charity regarding its funding, all though some friends left and other friends came on board. As we crossed over to becoming officially registered as a CIO financial record of incoming and outgoings have been recorded and officially a PayPal account for the charity has been opened for online giving along with a cash plus charity

bank account. Structure's have been and are being put into place as we move forward to fulfill the great purpose with passion and recur all the resources, we need to make it possible. As the founder I approached some friends who had known me and seen my passion for the work after several meetings a board of trustees formed:

- Director: David and Josephine Eaton
- Director: Shane Degan
- Director: Daniel M
- Lead Director: Brett Dewey

Since making the transition into a registered charity – goals and purposes of the mission and vision have become a lot more sharper and activity has been more precise. In the next section of this report, I will lay the activity of the charity in the first year.

3) Fountain Life Foundation first year activities as a Charity.

The purpose of the charity was already functioning to a degree prior to registration. Given the time and date of the charity registration there was a greater need then ever to be active in the purpose commissioned. We opted to use media during this season to convey a very important message of hope faith and love as well as the power of God and promises given in the Bible. The Charity went onto SKY 589 – Faith world T.V. This was funded by monthly partners. As discussed in our minutes at the board meeting, fund raising was achieved by looking to acquire supporters that donated monthly. Again a few faithful friends signed up to become monthly donors and with their generosity and the founder of the charities contribution we managed to get some funding for our activities.

Our activities and resources went completely to buying airtime on a Sky T.V 589 which broadcast reaches into homes in t he U.K and Europe.

The Charity also conducted a large number of outreaches and food distribution to feed those living on the streets. The administration of the Charity work took the gospel into Patmore Estate London which is known for knife crimes. Other locations were outside London being, Peterborough, Bedford, Luton, Milton Keynes and Isle of Wight. Aiming at drug addicts, Youth gang violence, Alcoholics, the homeless and those in the streets.

Fountain Life Foundation also grouped with a number of like-minded charities to form an Alliance across the U.K and did a tour reaching those in the streets, feeding the homeless and distributing bibles. locations included:

West Croydon, North London, Central London, Northampton, Southampton, Birmingham and Cardiff Wales.

This was of course subject to funds being available.

During the first year Josephine and David Eaton Resigned along with Daniel due to personal, family and other church charity commitments.

Michelle McCarthy, who was a faithful monthly donor was added to the board of Trustees.
