 - a) to organisations - to train their leaders and staff on how to support the bereaved and how to create bereavement friendly cultures.
 - b) to the UK public – to change public attitudes to bereavement and loss.
4. Helping bereaved parents capture and keep safe memories of their child by creatively photographing the child's room and their possessions, through a project called Treasured Memories.

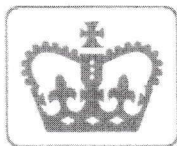
