The trustees present their report with the financial statements of the charity for the year ended 30 June 2025

**Objectives and principal activities**

The Objects of the CIO are, for the public benefit:-

to advance the Islamic religion in accordance with the teachings of the Quran and the teachings of Prophet Muhammed (peace be upon him) and his companions according to the interpretation and accepted view of the Ahlus Sunnah Wal Jamaa-ah and as expounded by the Salafus Saaliheen (Pious Predecessors); and to further Islamic education including the teaching of the Arabic language.

**Activities and progress**

The charity carries out Islamic education in pursuance of its charitable aims. The trustees consider that these activities, summarised below, provide benefit both to those who worship at our Mosque and the wider community of Leicester.

Our Mosque provides a centre for our prayers and worship for the activities associated with our faith.

During the year under review, we offered a range of religious services as follows:

Five times prayers are held every day

The Friday sermon and prayers are held every week.

Education and training is provided for the youth

Islamic Weddings – Nikah services are offered

Funeral assistance is provided as and when needed

Daily advices take place on Qur'an, Hadith and spirituality

Extra prayers are conducted in the month of Ramadan as well as the two festivals of Eid.

Occasional youth programs take place on different themes like addiction, charity, current issues etc.

External speakers are invited to deliver speeches and presentations on a wide range of topics.

Our hall is hired out to the members of the community for their family functions, graduations etc.

Local charities, NGOs and community groups have access to our facilities for meetings, community discussions etc.

The local MP is invited occasionally to speak with the congregation and to provide help and support.

**Recruitment and Appointment of Trustees**

The charity is governed by a board of trustees drawn from the local community. This is to ensure that the board has the skills and experience required to oversee the management of the charity and its operations.

The charity trustees are responsible for the general control and management of the charity. The trustees give their time freely and receive no remuneration or other financial benefits.

**Reserves Policy**

The trustees aim to ensure that sufficient funds are maintained to enable the charity to carry out its activities.

**Financial review**

The detailed results of the charities finances are set up in the accounts.

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
