The main purpose of The Harleston Shed is to promote social inclusion for the public benefit by preventing people (particularly, but not exclusively, men) aged 18 or over, within Harleston and the surrounding area, from becoming socially excluded.

During this initial period of formation, the Harleston Shed has held several breakfast meetings with potential, and existing, members to discuss the acquisition of a location for the Harleston Shed's operations. There have also been discussions with landowners of possible locations. Agreement has been reached with a local supplier for the provision of suitable Harleston Sheds, free of cost, when the siting has been agreed. Regular reports of progress have been published monthly in the Harleston Grapevine, the town's local magazine.

All of this has, as far as possible, involved the people the Harleston Shed is intended to benefit to keep them up to date on progress.

The Charity Commission's public benefit guidance has been taken into account when making any decision it is relevant to when conducting activities in these early stages of establishing the Harleston Shed.
