OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

A. To advance the religion of Islam, by means of, but not exclusively, promoting the teachings and tenets of Islam, provision of facilities for worship and provision of facilities for Islamic education in Sleaford.

B. Nothing in this constitution shall authorise an application of the property of the CIO for the purposes which are not charitable in accordance with [section 7 of the Charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005] and [section 2 of the Charities Act (Northern Ireland) 2008]

C. The promotion of religious harmony for the benefit of the public by promoting knowledge and mutual understanding and respect of the beliefs and practices of different religious faiths. In furtherance of these objects but not otherwise, the trustees shall have power: to establish or secure the establishment of a community centre and to maintain or manage or co-operate with any statutory authority in the maintenance and management of such a centre for activities promoted by the charity in furtherance of the above objects.

FINANCIAL REVIEW

Overheads are expected to be minimal and the charity's funds all set to fulfill the charity's objectives.

RESERVES POLICY

Reserves will be held in current accounts of accessibility.

PUBLIC BENEFIT REPORTING

The trustees confirm that they have referred to the guidance contained in the Charity Commission's general guidance on public benefit when reviewing the Association's aims and objectives and planning future activities. All of the trustees give their time freely and no remuneration was paid during the year.

**REPORT OF THE INDEPENDENT EXAMINERS TO THE TRUSTEES OF
