

Decision Making

£5,000 was allocated to an individual in financial hardship undertaking a course of study in social innovation, social entrepreneurship and the skills, methods and techniques required for the establishment and management of charitable, philanthropic and benevolent institutions. The individual is due to participate in the course from February to December 2022.

Provision of Bursaries

As allocated in the 2020/21 reporting year, the Year Here Foundation successfully distributed £10,000 in grant funding as bursaries to two people completing the course over the 2021/22 academic year.

In addition, £2,500 of the aforementioned £5,000 bursary was distributed in two instalments to one individual who is completing the course over the 2022 calendar year. The remaining £2,500 is due to be distributed in the next reporting period (1st September 2022 to 31st August 2023).
