The trustees present their report and the financial statements for the year ended 30 June 2025. The trustees who served during the year and up to the date of this report are set out on page 1.

### **Structure, governance and management**

FRDP International is a Charitable Incorporated Organisation (CIO) and registered with the Charity Commission as a charity on 2nd July 2020.

The CIO is governed by a constitution which sets out the powers of the charity. The trustees in charity law are responsible for the overall management and control of the charity working with other persons on an entirely voluntary basis.

Trustees are appointed in accordance with constitution. Once appointed, Trustees are given an introduction of the charity and its objects, Trustees are also given a full induction setting out the obligations of a trustee and provided with copies of the Charity Commission's guidance. The trustees meet every 3 months.

The trustees actively review the major risk to which the charity is exposed to on a regular basis, particularly those relating to its operations and finances. The system is established to mitigate these.

### **Objectives and activities for the public benefit**

The principal aims of the charity and objective of the charitable company are:

1. THE PREVENTION OR RELIEF OF POVERTY ANYWHERE IN THE WORLD, INCLUDING THOSE AFFECTED BY NATURAL DISASTER OR CONFLICT, BY PROVIDING: GRANTS, ITEMS AND SERVICES TO INDIVIDUALS IN NEED OR OTHER ORGANISATIONS WORKING TO PREVENT OR RELIEVE POVERTY.
2. FOR THE PUBLIC BENEFIT TO PROMOTE THE EDUCATION OF PEOPLE ANYWHERE IN THE WORLD IN SUCH WAYS AS THE CHARITY TRUSTEES THINK FIT.

### **Achievement and performance**

During the year ended 30 June 2025, FRDP International raised funds to support humanitarian relief and poverty alleviation programmes in Pakistan.

Funds raised were used to support initiatives including orphan sponsorship, assistance to widows and vulnerable families, construction of homes for flood-affected communities, small-scale water supply projects, and food distribution for low-income households. These programmes were implemented through local partners to ensure that assistance reached communities facing economic hardship and limited access to basic services.

Through these activities, the charity contributed to improving living conditions for vulnerable individuals and families while continuing to pursue its charitable objectives of poverty relief and community support.

### **Financial Review**

The charity relies on voluntary income which is £674,372 for the period ended 30th June 2025.

### **Plan for the future**

We will continue with our core activities of supporting the poor and needy the most poverty stricken areas of the world.



#### 1 Accounting policies

##### 1.1 Basis of accounting

The financial statements are prepared under the historic cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting standards in accordance with the requirements of the Charities Act 2011 ("the Act").

##### 1.2 Funding accounting

Unrestricted funds are general funds that are available for use at the trustees' discretion in furtherance of the objectives of the charity

Restricted funds are those donated for use in a particular area or for specific purpose, the use of which is restricted to that area or purpose.

##### 1.3 Incoming resources

All incoming resources are included in the statement of financial activities when the charity is entitled to the income and the amount can be quantified with reasonable accuracy.

##### 1.4 Resources expended

Expenditure is recognised on an accrual basis as a liability is incurred. Expenditure includes any VAT which cannot be fully recovered, and is reported as part of the expenditure to which it relates.

Governance costs include those costs associated with meeting the constitutional and statutory requirements of the charity and costs linked to the strategic management of the charity.

##### 1.5 Depreciation

Depreciation is calculated to write off the cost, less estimated residual values of tangible fixed assets over their estimated useful lives to the Charity. The annual depreciation rates and methods are as follows:-
