This provided vulnerable people with access to fresh food that would otherwise would not be possible.</p> <p>We also planted 3 community orchards (206 fruit trees) on public land; which will provide local residents with free fruit for many years to come.</p> <p>We went in and planted fruit trees into 12 local schools. Training and demonstrations were also provided to improve the children's knowledge.</p>
