### **Future plans**

### **Structure and governance and management**

The trustees are responsible for the overall management and control of Clwb Hapus Henllan and meet 3 times a year. The work of implementing most of the policies is carried out by Lynne Jones and Clybiau Plant Cymru.

All trustees give their time freely and no remuneration or expenses were paid in the year. No trustee or person connected with a trustee received any benefit from Clwb Hapus Henllan.

### **Risk management**

The trustees are responsible for the overseeing of the risks faced by Clwb Hapus Henllan. Detailed considerations of risk are delegated to the Headteacher of Ysgol Henllan. Risks are identified, assessed and controls established throughout the year. A review of the charities' risk management processes is undertaken on an annual basis/

The main risks that the trustees have identified and the plans to manage those risks are:

- Reputation. The Clwb Hapus Henllan success is built on its reputation for the high quality childcare. We manage the risks through safeguarding policies, staff recruitment policies, pastoral support for both pupils and staff and active identification and resolution of health and safety issues.
- Money. Our ability to continue is reliant on pupil fees and the ability to pay bills as they fall due. This risk is managed by marketing activity and having a reputation for excellence.

Through the risk management processes established for Clwb Hapus Henllan, the trustees are satisfied that the major risks identified have been adequately mitigated where necessary. It is recognised that systems can only provide reasonable but not absolute assurance that major risks have been adequately managed.
